

Managing 2006 and 2007 S2S Endpoints through the Transition to Adobe

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Overview



- Both the PureEdge (2006) and Adobe (2007) systems are in service during the Transition
- All Agencies are scheduled to be in Adobe by March 3, 2009

Overview



- Applicants visiting Grants.gov GUI hit the Adobe (2007) system but "see" opportunities posted by agencies on both systems
- Agencies can post opportunities & packages to both the PureEdge (2006) and Adobe (2007) system
 - Agencies can only post in PureEdge up until Build
 2008 03 is deployed (Date of deployment TBD)
- S2S connections <u>REQUIRE</u> Applicant and Agency ATTENTION!
- 2006 System S2S cutoffs are planned on or after 11/30/2008

Agency S2S Connection Notes



- Agencies are Posting to the 2007 (Adobe) System now!
 - Adobe Packages will Increase
 - If Agencies do not move their S2S connection to the 2007 endpoint, they will <u>NOT</u> be able to retrieve Adobe submissions through S2S
 - Agencies can wait to move S2S endpoint (and download Adobe submissions manually)
 - Agencies can move S2S endpoint now
- Connecting to 2007 Endpoint to retrieve will Display Adobe Form Characteristics (see the grants.gov website for PureEdge vs. Adobe FAQs at:

Applicants S2S Connection Notes



- All Submissions Made via an S2S Connection to the 2007 System are Stored in the 2007 System
 - This Includes Submissions for 2006 Opportunities
- Submissions to 2006 Opportunities Made through the 2007 Endpoint will Look and Feel like Adobe Submissions
 - They will Display Adobe Form Characteristics
 - Some Agencies have not Made the Switch to Allow Adobe
 Submissions
 - If Submissions are Made to 2007 System, and the agency is Still Connected to the 2006 Endpoint system;
 - Agency will not Receive the Submissions
 - Coordinate with the Agency to Ensure you are Submitting to the Correct Server

Do Applicant S2S Clients Need to Change their Software to Submit to the 2007 server? GRANTS.GOV®

FIND. APPLY. SUCCEED!

- If the Application was Downloaded from the 2007 System and Submitted to the 2007 System <u>NO</u> Change is Required
- Every Effort has been Made to Maintain Identical Interfaces
 - There is a Need for a Small Change to S2S
 Connections Before Using the 2007 Endpoint for 2006 System Submissions:
 - 2007 S2S Endpoint Users <u>MUST</u> Include the 'schemaLocation' Element in the XML

What is the Requirement for the 'schemaLocation' Element in the Submission XML? GRANTS.GOV®

- The 'schemaLocation' Element is <u>ONLY</u> for 2006 Submissions to the 2007 System
- If an Agency is Accepting only 2006 server Submissions;
 - The S2S Interface Must Download that Opportunity from 2006 and Submit to the 2006 System Endpoint
- If the S2S Connection is Submitting to the 2006 System with the 'schemaLocation' Element;
 - The S2S Connection will get Mixed Results
 - May Include Submission Failures

Can an Applicant S2S Connection Login and Download a 2006 Submission from the 2007 system?

YES

 An S2S Connection <u>CAN</u> Login and Create a 2006 Submission from 2007 System then connect to 2006 system to Submit *IF The Schema Header is Modified*

Can I tell by the Grants.gov Tracking Number if it is a Adobe or PureEdge submission? GRANTS.GOV®

FIND. APPLY. SUCCEED.

- An Adobe Tracking Number Begins as GRANT followed by the number 1
 - Example Grant1xxx
- A PureEdge Tracking Number Always Begins as Grant followed by the number 0
 - Example Grant0xxxx

Endpoints



- Endpoint or Port: To Access the 2007 Web Services Use the Following Endpoints:
 - AT07: https://at07web.grants.gov:446/app-s2s-server/services/
 .NET users https://at07ws.grants.gov:446/app-s2s-server/services/
 - Production-2007: https://ws07.grants.gov:446/app-s2s-server/services/
- Certificates: There are No New Certificates Needed for 2007 Test System
 - Utilize Existing 2006 Test Certificates
 - Note: Firewall port 446 should be open to address the new URL http://ws07.grants.gov
