

Request to List Herbicide-Sensitive Crop Locations

For a sensitive crop site to be listed on the Kansas Department of Agriculture website, the following criteria must be met:

- The crop is grown for commercial purposes and represents a legitimate source of income for the grower.
- The crop – grapes, cotton or tomatoes – is known for its propensity to be economically damaged by herbicides that volatilize readily.
- If it is an organic crop, it must be produced under an organic certification program.
- The grower requests that we publicize the location on this website.

Herbicide-sensitive crops include vineyards, cotton, tomatoes, certified organic crops and greenhouse crops. Other crops may be included and will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

By signing this request, I authorize the Kansas Department of Agriculture to make the location of my sensitive crops available on its website. I understand that to have that information removed from their website that I must submit a written request to the KDA Pesticide and Fertilizer Program at the address listed above.
