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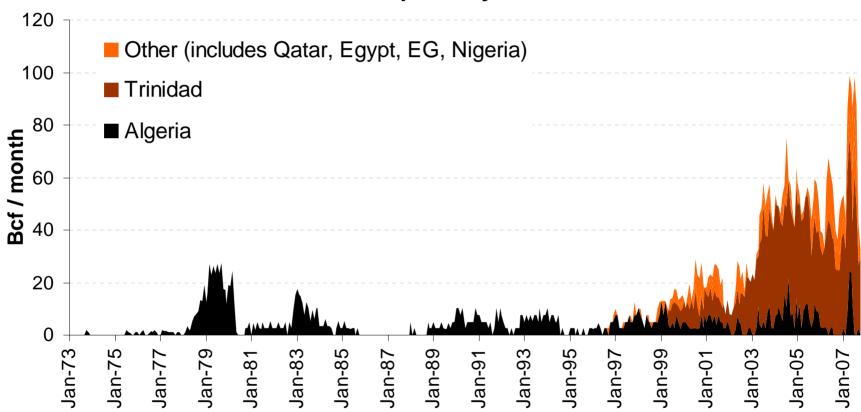

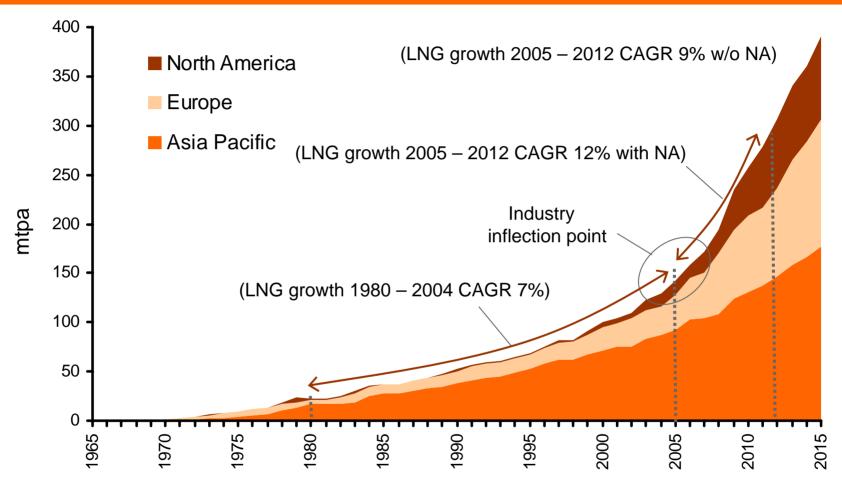
US LNG imports – the story so far

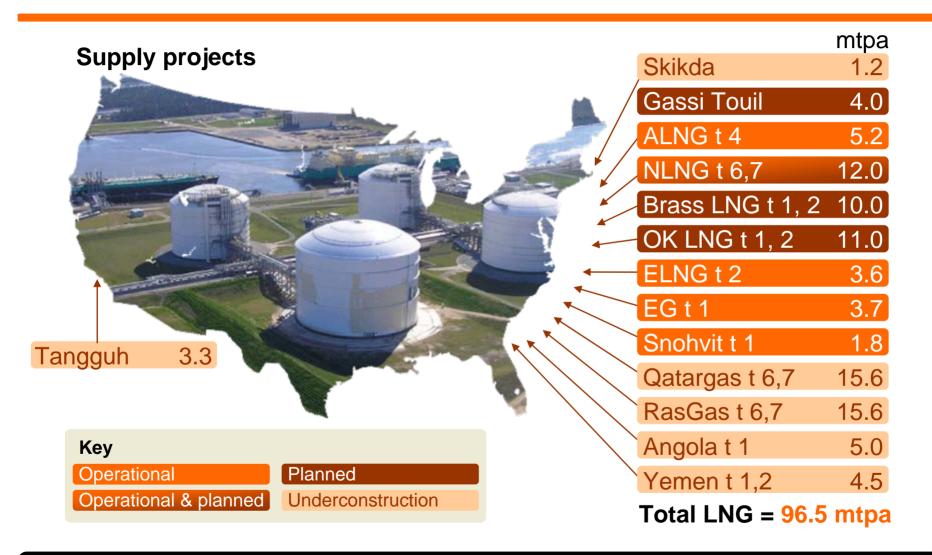

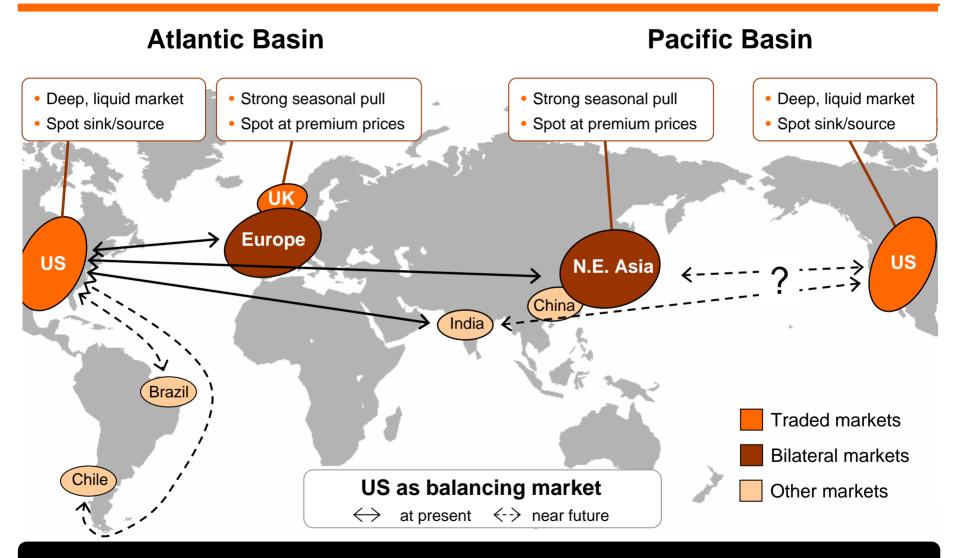
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US LNG market – engine of growth 2002+

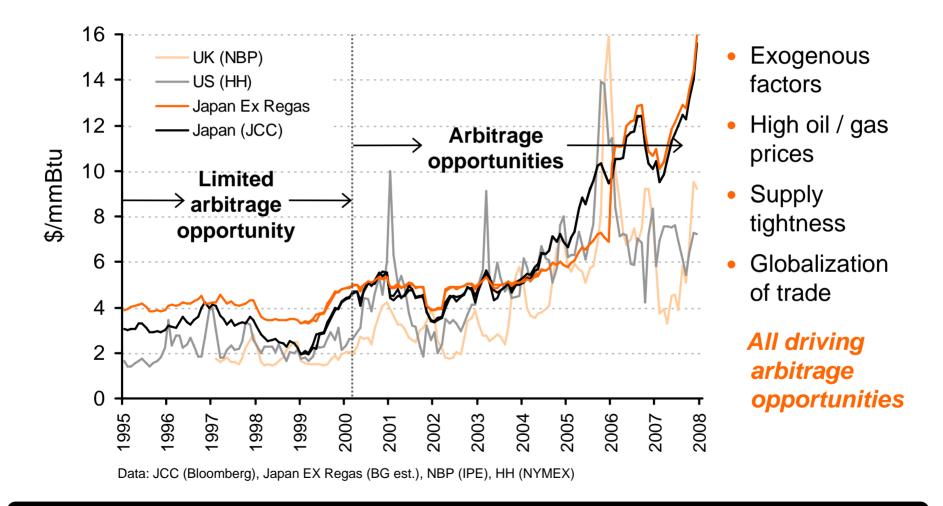


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US LNG market – a global sink/source



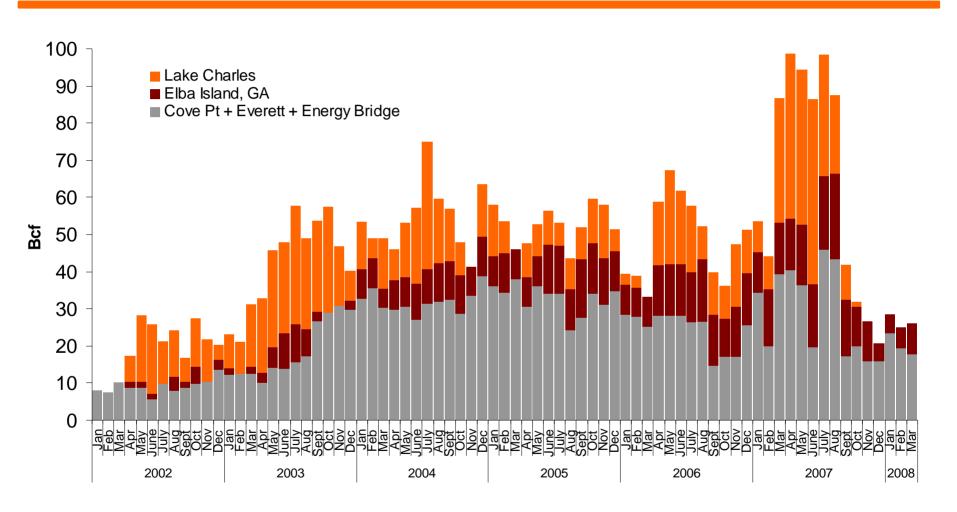
Natural Gas prices – various markets



Lake Charles import terminal



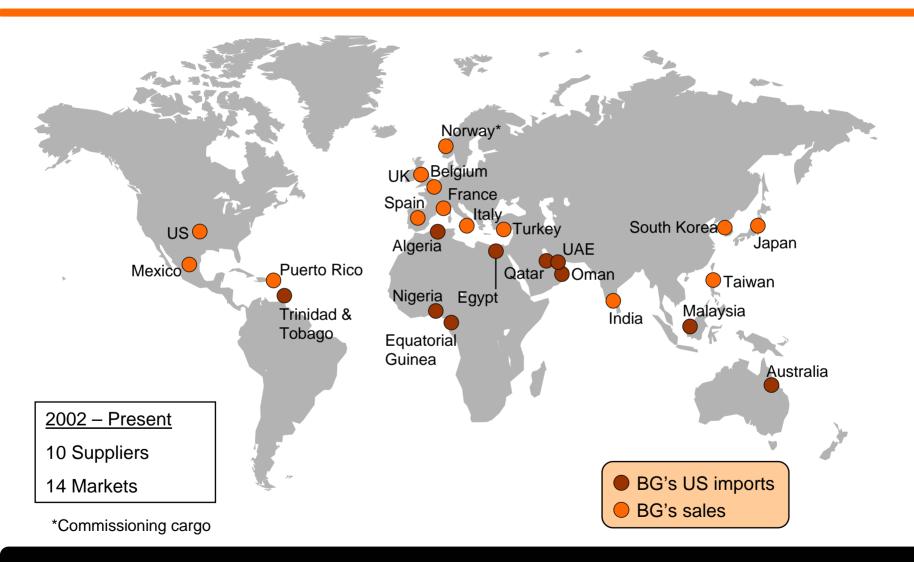
US LNG imports 2002 – 2008

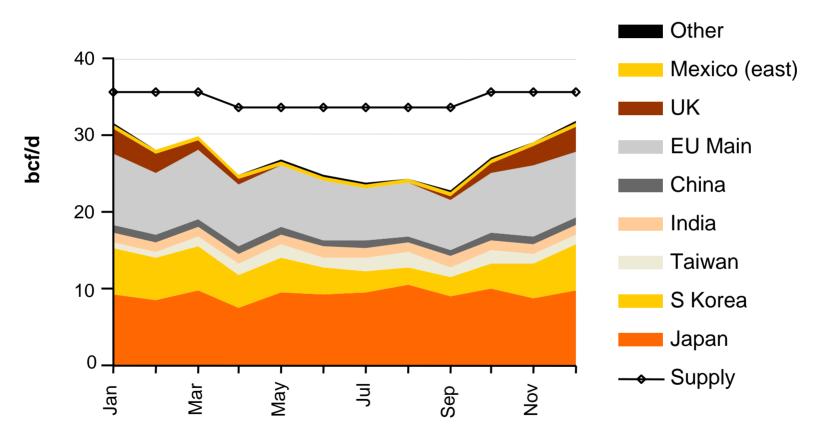
Issues - FERC agenda Nov. 2007

2010 view of the global LNG balance

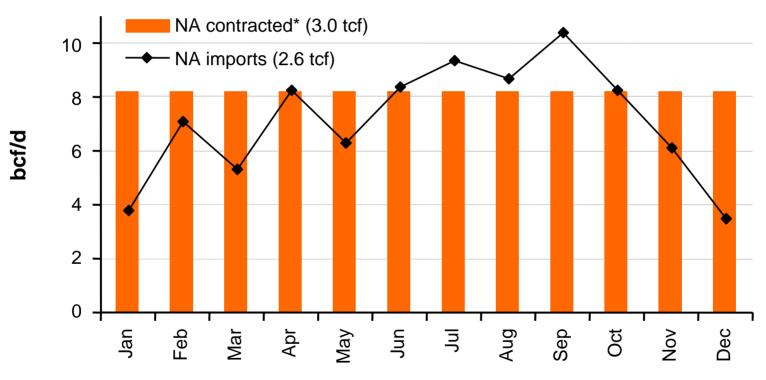

2010 estimated North American LNG volumes by month

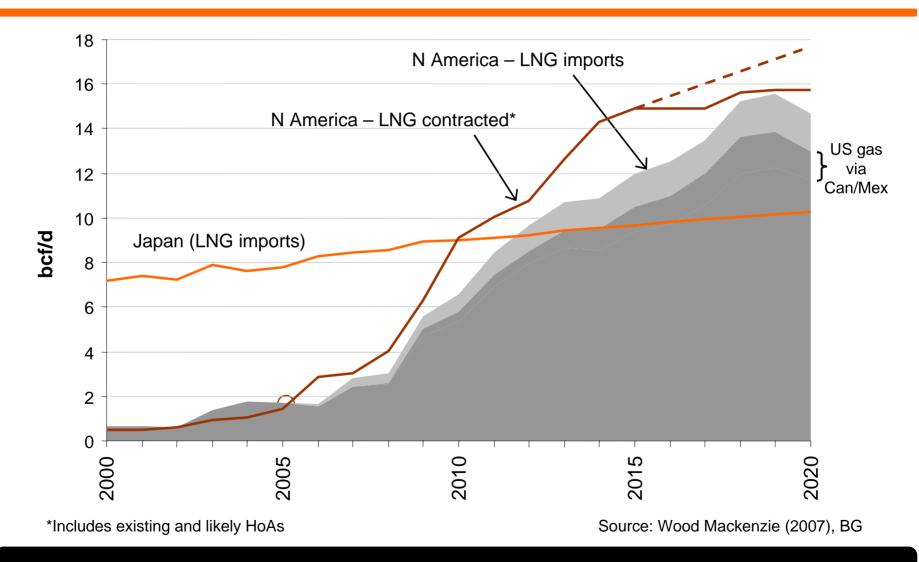


NA inflow (spot)/outflow (divert) by month
