## Appendix 4 – Part 1: UNTL/Dublin Core Crosswalk

Mapping among the widely used metadata elements is important in order to facilitate accurate conversions among various metadata element sets. Accordingly, the UNTL to Dublin Core Metadata Element set, (version 1.1, DC-simple) Crosswalk will enable harvesting of data records from DC-compatible records to populate our UNTL metadata records. The crosswalk will also enable the exportation/importation of MARC records from/to our own library online catalogs.

The Dublin Core metadata element set is a standard for cross-domain information resource description which promotes the widespread adoption of interoperable metadata standards. Ongoing efforts of DC initiative participants include the collaborative development and continual refinement of metadata conventions based on research and feedback between Working Groups, which are organized around specific problem domains.
