RULES ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Court's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Rule 40, call for the appointment of a Rules Advisory Committee. By Rule, the Committee members may serve up to three consecutive terms of two years. This year there will be four vacancies created by the expiration of the terms of those members.

The Court is accepting letters of interest from members of the Court's bar indicating a willingness to serve on the Court's Rules Advisory Committee.

The Court is in the process of a major revision to its Rules of Practice and Procedure and incorporation of Rules to implement electronic filing. The Rules Advisory Committee will be requested to provide comment and advice regarding the proposed amendments.
