- The Army Reserve Employer Partnership Initiative is a joint public-private venture through which Employers and the Army Reserve share Soldiers-Employees. Rather than compete for personnel, the Army Reserve and Employers mutually recruit a Soldier for the Army Reserve and for a civilian business or Employers open up opportunities in their companies for career placement of Army Reserve Soldiers. Employers and the Army Reserve also collaborate on challenges that affect an Employer's ability to hire and retain an Army Reserve Soldiers, e.g., licensing and credentialing reciprocity, HR systems and terminology, etc. This one-of-a-kind initiative provides a mechanism for the Army Reserve and civilian industries to share the common goals of strengthening the community, supporting Army Reserve Soldiers and their Families, and maintaining a strong economy.

- Title 10, US Code, prescribes that there will be an Army Reserve Forces Policy Committee (ARFPC) within the Office of the Secretary of the Army and that it provide recommendations to the Secretary of the Army on major policy issues directly affecting the Reserve Components of the Army or the mobilization readiness of the Army. It is the only forum in Headquarters Department of the Army that requires, by law, equal representation of all three components of the Army. It has fifteen voting members, all, in practice, are general officers who are appointed by the Secretary of the Army.

- Responsible for all Selective Service System operations in the Northeastern and Midwestern United States. Responsible for the recruitment, training, and retention of approximately 4K presidentially appointed Selective Service System Board members, a registration awareness program across a sixteen-state area, interface with governors and legislators on Selective Service legislation and requirements, and the training and recruitment of 155 military officers from all services and 18 governor-appointed State Directors

- Responsible for the day-to-day operations of the Region I Headquarters of the Selective Service System. Developed an officer career management program to ensure that highly competitive military officers were recruited to serve in the Region, were meeting all their educational and professional development requirements, rewarded for excellence, and promoted ahead of their peers. Due to staffing shortfalls, also ran the operations and training programs of the 4K presidentially appointed Selective Service System Board Members assigned to the Region. Designed the Region I Intranet website, and, for several months, ran the National Selective Service System website when the webmaster left to work elsewhere.
