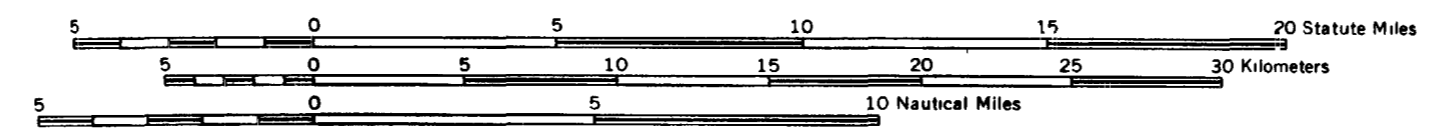


The boundaries of the regular blocks are 4,800 international meters on a side and contain 2,304 hectares. The regular bound areas are defined in terms of X and Y coordinates of the Universal Transverse Mercator Grid System based on the Geodetic Reference System (GRS) 80 Ellipsoid.

Although not shown, the 200 nautical mile Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) limit lies within this diagram.
