Except for substituting Zip Codes for zone numbers, today's U.S. Postal Service would likely offer the same advice for postal customers in December 2006. Another difference would be that the boy and girl depicted might today be bringing their own young grandchildren to the post office.

Featuring two packages addressed to "Mail Me Early 4 Merry Xmas" in "Anywhere, U.S.A.," this publicity photograph was part of the Chicago Post Office's 1955 efforts "to induce the mailing public to stagger their mailings according to the destination of the mail. This intent also included such features as using zone numbers, separating local mail from
