

#### Baseball Uniforms for the Potawatomi Indian Reservation



Baseball was an important part of life in many communities in the early twentieth century. Companies such as Schmelzer Arms of Kansas City, Missouri manufactured sports equipment for the many local teams as well as . The Schmelzer Arms Company was founded by a German immigrant in Leavenworth, Kansas in 1857. Thirty years later, the owners moved the business to Kansas City. Originally a gun store, the company became a national leader in the sporting goods business.

In this letter, dated June 12, 1919, the company provided the Superintendent of the nearby Potawatomi Indian Agency with a requested quote for baseball uniforms to be worn by the Mayetta Indians. According to a notation on the document, the uniforms were ordered by telephone.
