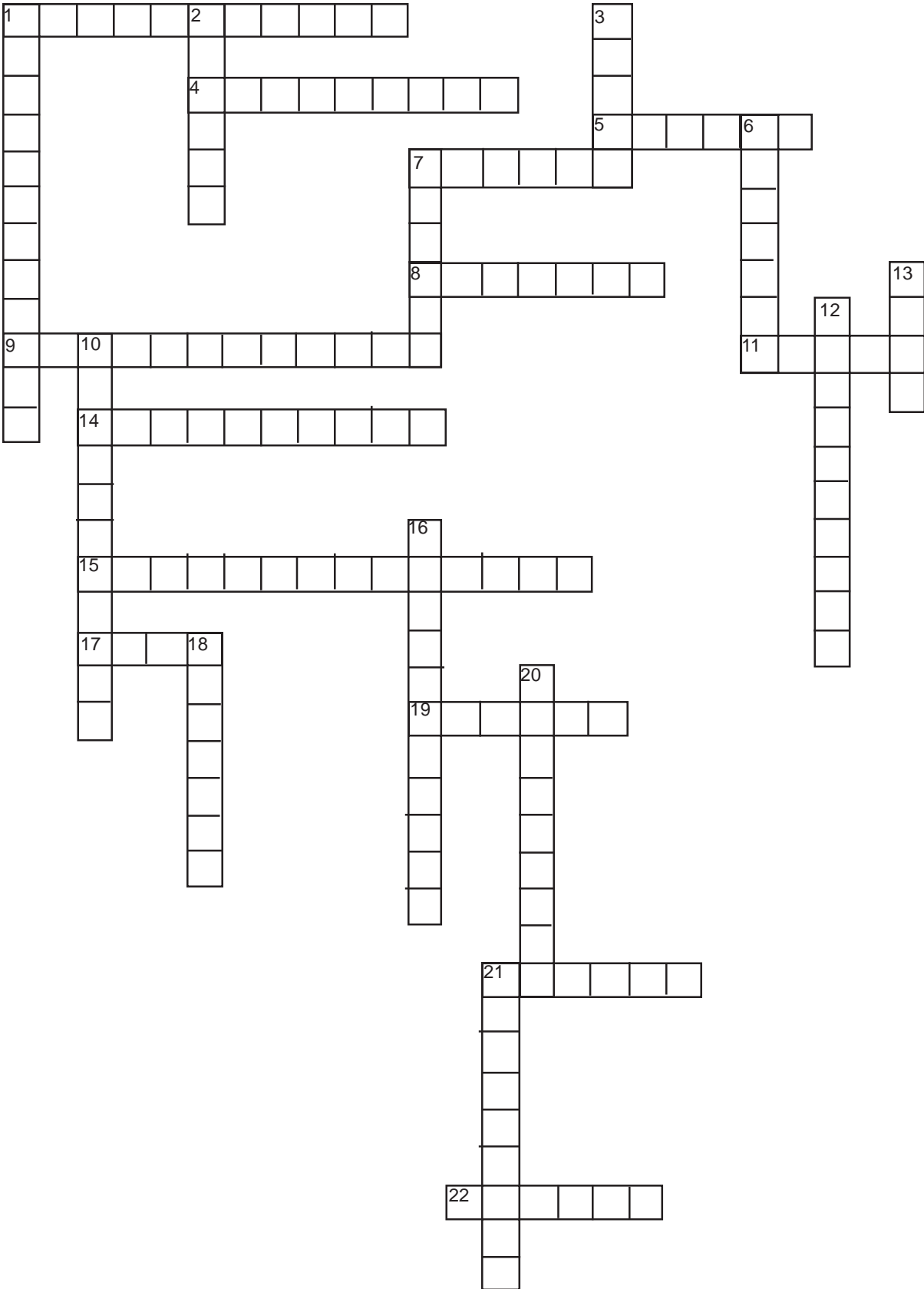


Alaskan Crossword Puzzle
