

All MSHA - All-Injury Rates CY 2002 - 2011




- The All-Injury Rate decreased 41 percent from 4.60 in CY 2002 to 2.73 in CY 2011.
- The All-Injury Rate decreased 25 percent from 3.64 in CY 2006 to 2.73 in CY 2011.

Coal - All-Injury Rates CY 2002 - 2011




- The All-Injury Rate for Coal mines decreased 44 percent from 6.03 in CY 2002 to 3.38 in CY 2011.
- The All-Injury Rate for Coal mines decreased 24 percent from 4.46 in CY 2006 to 3.38 in CY 2011.

- The All-Injury Rate for MNM mines decreased 41 percent from 3.86 in CY 2002 to 2.28 in CY 2011.
- The All-Injury Rate for MNM mines decreased 29 percent from 3.19 in CY 2006 to 2.28 in CY 2011.
