SILICON IN NOVEMBER 2008

Preliminary data for November 2008 indicate that domestic production and net shipments of silicon ferroalloys, on a gross-weight basis, decreased by 20% and slightly, respectively, compared with those in October 2008, according to the U.S. Geological Survey. Ending stocks were 7% lower than those at the end of October. Stocks included adjustments in inventory and in-plant consumption of ferrosilicon to produce magnesium ferrosilicon and other miscellaneous alloys.

Production and net shipments during the first 11 months of 2008 increased by 7% and 5%, respectively, compared with the revised amounts of those during the same period in 2007 [247,000 metric tons (t), production; 204,000 t, net shipments]. Production-related statistics for silicon metal were concealed to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

On a gross-weight basis, U.S. ferrosilicon and silicon metal exports in October 2008 were 27% lower and 16% higher,

respectively, than those in September 2008. U.S. ferrosilicon and silicon metal exports in the first 10 months of 2008 were 15,600 t and 29,600 t, respectively; these were 67% and 28% higher, respectively, than those during the same period in 2007.

On a gross-weight basis, U.S. ferrosilicon and silicon metal imports in October 2008 were 15% higher and 25% lower, respectively, than those in the prior month. U.S. ferrosilicon and silicon metal imports during the first 10 months of 2008 were 254,000 t and 144,000 t, respectively; these were 6% lower and 19% higher, respectively, than those during the same period in 2007.
