


In 2006, injuries and illnesses requiring days away from work declined by 4.1 percent. The decline was by 3.5 percent in goods-producing industries and 4.5 percent in service-providing industries.

Injuries and illnesses with days away from work represented 29 percent of all injury and illness cases in both 2005 and 2006.
