**Note:** Vessel IFQ Caps are calculated on the IFQ TAC only; CDQ TACs are not included in the calculations.

- QSP = Quota Share Pool or Pools; IFQ = Individual Fishing Quota; TAC = Total Allowable Catch.
- Halibut weights are expressed in net (headed and gutted) pounds, and sablefish weights are expressed in round pounds.
- The sablefish vessel cap for area SE has changed because the TAC and IFQ Program allocations were revised under a Federal Register (FR) correction notice filed and effective March 14, 2008. The change was required because the Annual Specifications of Groundfish TAC was incorrect as originally published in the FR, and the vessel cap was based on that TAC.

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
