

Assessment ideas are included in each *Milk Matters* lesson activity and in the *Lactose Intolerance Discussion Guide*. Here are additional ways you can test whether or not your students have achieved the learning objectives outlined in the *Milk Matters* classroom activities:

- Conduct a “quiz show” with questions about information presented in the lesson.
- Ask students to design and write a test, exchange tests, and complete them.
- Have students give oral reports or create outlines about what they have learned.
- Ask students to interview each other about their knowledge of calcium and bone health.
- Encourage students to create collages of pictures of calcium-rich foods or a kid’s picture book presenting information in simple terms.
- Have students fill out Venn diagrams and other graphic organizers.
- Conduct “one minute paper” variations in which students write one or two sentences summarizing what they learned in class and what they would still like to know.
- Have students create calcium-rich meals or snacks.
