

INFORMATION + DIRECTIONS FOR WRD SPEAKERS

Thank you for coming to give a seminar as part of our Water Resources Division seminar series!

Time: 12:00 pm - noon (unless otherwise stated). Talks are scheduled for 1 hour, but we usually recommend leaving at least 15 minutes for questions (taken during or at the end of the talk). Please meet us in the room **30 minutes** prior to your seminar so that we may get you set up, iron out any technical difficulties, and have time to chat.

Audience: Depending on the topic you can generally expect anywhere from 15 – 45 people with backgrounds in hydrology, chemistry, geology, microbiology, ecology, toxicology and mathematical modeling.

Audiovisual: Please let us know in advance what you require. We have computer, slide and overhead projectors. If you would like to use a computer projector you can either bring your own laptop or bring the presentation on CD or USB drive. Let us know if you will need a PC (we have no MAC laptops).

Location: The Menlo Park Campus of the U.S. Geological Survey is located at 345 Middlefield Road Menlo Park, California 94025-3591. WRD seminars are held in Building 15 room 3245 (unless otherwise stated). See the map of the campus and directions on the following page.

Parking: The easiest and best place to park is the guest parking found on the traffic circle in front of the building 3 Visitor Center, just past where you enter on Survey Lane. If this is full (a rare occurrence), you may park in any lot on the campus.

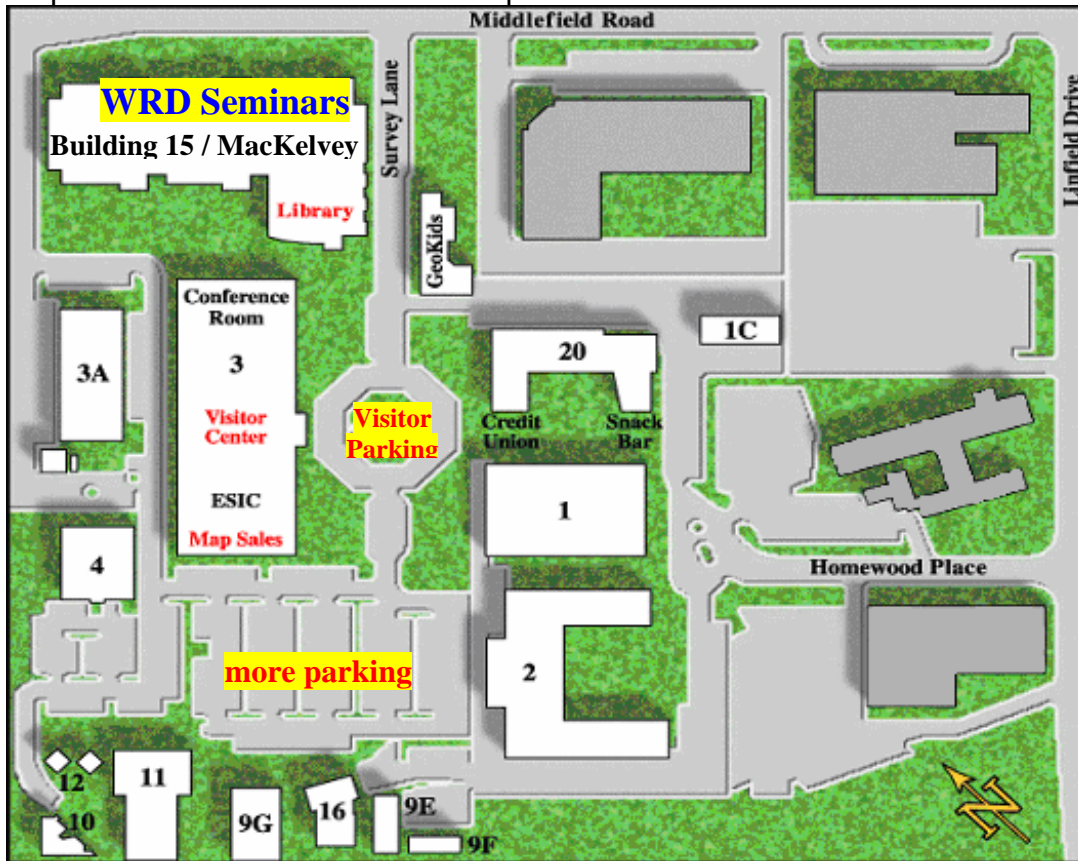

Driving directions:

- **From US 101**, take the Willow Road exit west to Menlo Park. DRIVE 1 mile to Middlefield Road, TURN RIGHT (northwest), DRIVE 2 blocks, and TURN LEFT on Survey Lane at 345 Middlefield Road.
- **From El Camino Real (US 82)**, TURN NORTHEAST on Ravenswood Road in Menlo Park, DRIVE to the T-junction at Middlefield Road, TURN RIGHT and proceed 2 blocks to the USGS main entrance at 345 Middlefield Road, and TURN RIGHT (southwest) on Survey Lane at 345 Middlefield Road.
- **To Use Public Transportation** on the Peninsula, TAKE CalTrain to the Menlo Park Station, and then the SamTrans Bus 296 (Purdue and Fordham) to the campus. [Or, it's less than a mile walk from the train station to the campus.]
- **To Walk to the Campus** from the CalTrain station, head south from the train station about 100 yards to Ravenswood Avenue. TURN LEFT (northeast) and walk down Ravenswood about a half a mile to Middlefield Road, turn right (southeast) and the campus is on the right hand side of the street. TURN RIGHT (west) on Survey Lane.
