### ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO RULE 3a12-8

The Commission has adopted amendments to Rule 3a12-8 (Rule) under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 that designate debt obligations issued by the Republics of Ireland and Italy as exempted securities for the purpose of permitting the marketing and trading of futures contracts on those securities in the United States of U.S. persons and change the references to the names of the countries listed in the Rule to their official names. Publication of the adopting release is expected in the Federal Register during the week of January 13. (Rel. 34-30166; International Series Rel. 357)

### CAPSTEAD SECURITIES CORPORATION IV

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 3 to request a hearing on an application filed by Capstead Securities Corporation IV for a conditional order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act. The conditional order would exempt applicant from all provisions of the Act in connection with the proposed issuance and sale of collateralized mortgage obligations and residual interests relating thereto, and the election of REMIC status. ## ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
