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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### CEASE AND DESIST ORDER ENTERED AGAINST THE STATE BANK OF PAKISTAN

The Commission today issued an Order Instituting Cease and Desist Proceedings pursuant to Section 8A of the Securities Act of 1933 and Findings and Order against the State Bank of Pakistan. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement wherein the State Bank admitted certain findings and consented to the sanction imposed.

The State Bank consented to issuance of an order finding that it violated Section 5(c) of the Securities Act of 1933 by participating in and directing the offer in the United States of bearer certificates issued by the government of Pakistan. Specifically, the order finds that the State Bank arranged for advertisements for the certificates to be placed in United States newspapers, claiming, among other things, that there would be "No Questions Asked About Source of Funds," and that the certificates were not subject to taxation. The order finds that the certificates, offered through United States branches of Pakistani commercial banks, were unregistered securities not subject to any exemption from registration pursuant to Section 5.

The order requires the State Bank to permanently cease and desist from committing or causing any violation of, and committing or causing any future violation of, Section 5 of the Securities Act. (Rel. 33-6937 - May 6)

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### ATTORNEY DAVID TALLANT ENJOINED

On May 4, the Honorable Stanley S. Harris, U.S. District Judge for the District of Columbia, permanently enjoined David A. Tallant, a California attorney, with his consent and without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint. Tallant was enjoined from violating or aiding and abetting violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as well as several other provisions thereunder, in connection with defendant Paul A. Bilzerian's illegal scheme to acquire the securities of Hammermill Paper Company (Hammermill). In its complaint, the Commission alleged that Tallant aided and abetted Bilzerian's fraudulent scheme to conceal the true source of the funds he used to acquire Hammermill stock. Specifically, the complaint alleged that Tallant served as the trustee for a series of sham trusts involving the various investors in Bilzerian's stock acquisition effort that were designed to conceal the identities of the investors.

The Court had previously issued an Order of Partial Summary Judgment and Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction Against Defendant Paul A. Bilzerian (Bilzerian) finding that Bilzerian had violated numerous provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the rules thereunder, in connection with his acquisitions of four different securities during the 1985-88 period. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
