COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ADDITIONS AND CORRECTIONS

The SEC Digest published on September 4th was assigned an erroneous issue number. The number should have been Issue 92-173.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

JAMES DONAHUE BARRED AND INVESTMENT ADVISER REGISTRATION OF BROKER SERVICES, INC. REVOKED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings pursuant to Sections 203(e) and (f) of the Investment Advisers Act against James Donahue and Broker Services, Inc. of Englewood, Colorado. Donahue and Broker Services each submitted an Offer of Settlement consenting to the Orders which find that, without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint, on August 7, 1992, Donahue and Broker Services were permanently enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado from violating the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act and the Securities Exchange Act, and the books and records provisions of the Advisers Act [SEC v. James Donahue, Hedged Investments Associates, Inc., and Broker Services, Inc., Civil Action No. 92-C-1231, August 7, 1992] (LR-13276). The Orders also find that Donahue was convicted of one criminal count of securities fraud in violation of Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5. The Orders revoke the registration of Broker Services, Inc. as an investment adviser, and permanently bar Donahue from association with any broker or dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING AGAINST KAREN SCHERM

The Commission instituted public proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Karen L. Scherm, a person formerly associated with a registered broker-dealer. Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Scherm's Offer of Settlement in which she consented to an order permanently barring her from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment adviser or investment company. In her Offer of Settlement Scherm neither admitted nor denied the Commission's findings, except for findings that on July 15, 1992, she was permanently enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Georgia from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 [SEC v. Karen Scherm, Civil Action No. 1 92-CV-1145-JOF, N.D. GA.], and that on June 3, 1991, she pled guilty to one count each of securities fraud and mail fraud. (Rel. 34-31132)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

On August 14, 1992 the Government Securities Clearing Corporation filed a proposed rule change (SR-GSCC-92-08) under Section 19(b)(3)(A) which would allow GSCC to impose a fee of \$500 on netting members for their netting system activity. The proposed rule change became effective on filing. Publication of the proposal in the Federal Register is expected during the week of September 7. (Rel. 34-31137)

The Government Securities Clearing Corporation has filed with the Commission a proposed rule change (SR-GSCC-92-07) that would modify GSCC's criteria for comparison of trade data. Publication of the proposal in the Federal Register is expected during the week of September 7. (Rel. 34-31138)

The Depository Trust Company has filed a proposed rule change (SR-DTC-92-13) under Section 19(b)(3)(A) that enables DTC's Dividend Reinvestment Service and Optional Dividend Procedures to be accessed through the Elective Dividends function on DTC's Participant Terminal System. The proposed rule change became effective on filing. Publication of the proposal in the Federal Register is expected during the week of September 7. (Rel. 34-31139)

International Securities Clearing Corporation filed with the Commission a proposed rule change (SR-ISCC-92-02), effective upon filing, regarding a revised letter of understanding that ISCC will use in connection with its Global Clearance Network Service. Publication of the proposed rule change is expected in the Federal Register during the week of September 7. (Rel. 34-31140; International Series Rel. No. 449)

On August 6, 1992, the Philadelphia Stock Exchange filed with the Commission, pursuant to Rule 19b-4 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, a proposal (SR-PHLX-92-20) to amend its rules by adding Options Floor Procedure Advice FF-17, entitled Foreign Currency Options Trades to be Effected in the Pit, which will require each bid and offer represented for execution on the FCO floor to be voiced loudly and audibly in the option's trading pit. The Advice also proposes to provide PHLX floor officials with the authority to extend for any FCO trading segment the boundaries of a trading pit to include other common areas available on the floor of trading. Publication of the notice is expected in the Federal Register during the week of September 7. (Rel. 34-31143)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF A PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has noticed amendments to and granted accelerated approval of a proposed rule change submitted by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-91-27) that provides for the listing and trading of options on the Keefe, Bruyette & Woods, Inc. Bank Index, which is a capitalization-weighted index composed of 24 geographically representative U.S. commercial bank stocks. Publication of the approval order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of September 7. (Rel. 34-31145)
