INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MECFINT (JERSEY) LIMITED

An order has been issued exempting Mecfint (Jersey) Limited, a Jersey (Channel Islands) corporation, from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-14372 - Feb. 13)

THE COMMONWEALTH GROUP, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 8 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Commonwealth Group, Inc. and Commonwealth Capital Management Inc. for an order exempting them from Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 22c-1 and 22d-1. This will permit Applicants to assess a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of its shares and waive the contingent deferred sales charge respecting certain types of redemptions. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued concerning a proposal by Jersey Central Power & Light Company (JCP&L), subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, and its newly formed subsidiary, Energy Initiatives Incorporated (EII). The proposal involves the issuance and sale of common stock by EII to JCP&L, the making of open account advances from JCP&L to EII, and secured and/or unsecured borrowings by EII. This order indicates what information shall be included in the Rule 24 certificates. (Rel. 35-23600 - Feb. 13)

NEW ENGLAND POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing New England Power Company, subsidiary of New England Electric System, to issue and pledge up to \$165 million of first mortgage bonds from time to time through December 31, 1986. (Rel. 35-23601 - Feb. 13)

CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 11 to request a hearing on a proposal by Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, CSW Energy, Inc., to permit Energy to spend an additional \$2 million for further studies, investigations and research. MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC.

Orders have been issued regarding Middle South Utilities, Inc., a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Louisiana Power & Light Company (LP&L) and Mississippi Power & Light Company (MP&L), authorizing Middle South to acquire and LP&L and MP&L to issue and sell their common stock, through December 31, 1985, for a cash consideration not to exceed \$100 million and \$30,015,000, respectively. ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF AMENDED PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, an amended proposed rule change filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-Phlx-84-13) that establishes a series of Option Floor Procedure Advices applicable to specialists, registered options traders and floor brokers, establishes a pre-set fine schedule for violation of the Advices, and changes some of the Phlx rules so that they are consistent with the Advices. ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-PSE-85-3) to allow the delisting of series of options that have no open interest. (Rel. 34-21761)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
