# **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS**

KEZER-WOLFENDEN, INC. SANCTIONED

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 against Rezer-Wolfenden, Inc., a registered investment adviser with its principal place of business in Worcester, Massachusetts.

The Order Instituting Proceedings alleges that Kezer-Wolfenden wilfully violated Section 204 of the Advisers Act by failing to: keep required books and records; file an annual report; and file amendments to its registration application.

Simultaneously with the institution of proceedings, the Commission accepted an Offer of Settlement in which Kezer-Wolfenden, without admitting or denying the allegations, consented to findings and an order by the Commission which censures it, suspends it from soliciting any new clients for 60 days, and provides that it will undertake to file an affidavit stating compliance with the suspension at the expiration of the 60day suspension. ## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND ORDER PREEZING ASSETS GRANTED AS TO THOMAS REID, OTHERS

The New York and Fort Worth Regional Offices announced that on February 11 Judge John F. Reenan, U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York, issued orders temporarily restraining four defendants from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud and margin provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The four defendants are: Thomas W. Reid, a businessman and private investor from Grandview, Texas, a suburb of the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex; Maurice Rind, a business and former stockbroker from Los Angeles, California. B. f. M. Investments. The Corporation believed to be involved in securinia; B & M Investments, Inc., a Texas corporation believed to be involved in securities investing, of which Rind is president; and Michael Joe Rogers, an attorney, businessman and investor practicing law in Cleburne, Texas, also a suburb of the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. Judge Reenan also froze the defendants assets and provided that: Rind and Rogers may spend up to \$250 per day in living expenses in addition to spending monies for travel expenses from their homes to the Southern District of New York; and Reid may sell securities of First City Properties, Inc., provided he immediately deposits all sales proceeds with the Clerk of the Court. APEXX INVESTING GROUP, INC. ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on February 11 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Apexx Investing Group, Inc. of Los Angeles, California. The Judgment enjoined Apexx from failing to file periodic reports and Notifications of Late Filing on time.

The Commission alleged, in its November 1, 1984 complaint, that Apexx, as part of a continuing course of conduct, failed to file or filed late periodic reports on 14 separate occasions and failed to file required Notifications of Late Filing on five separate occasions. Apexx, consenting to the Court's Judgment, admitted that it had failed to file timely Annual and Quarterly Reports and failed to file Notifications of Late Filing. (SEC v. Apexx Investing Group, Inc., USDC DC, Civil Action No. 84-3336). (LR-10683)

#### JOHN W. KEOGH CONSENTS TO FINAL ORDER

The Commission announced that on February 19 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered a Final Order against John W. Keogh, of Jackson, Wyoming and the Executive Vice President and Director of the Ultimate Corp. in Clark, New Jersey. The Court ordered Keogh to timely file in the future Form 4 Statements of Changes in Beneficial Ownership of Securities as required by Section 16(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Rule 16a-1 and Form 4. Keogh consented to the Final Order without admitting or denying the factual allegations of the Commission's complaint. (SEC v. John Keogh, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 84-2255). (LR-10684)

#### PMG HOUSING PARTNERS 1984-IV

An order has been issued exempting PMG Housing Partners 1984-IV, a California limited partnership, from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-14393 - Feb. 26)
