COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

ADDITION TO WEEKLY CALENDAR

Chairman John S.R. Shad will testify on March 6 before the House Energy and Commerce Committee, Oversight and Investigations Subcommittee concerning the accounting profession. The hearing will be held at 10:00 a.m., in Room 2123, Rayburn House Office Building.

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION ENTERED AGAINST MARCH RESOURCES LTD., OTHERS

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on February 28 in the U.S. District Court for the Western District of Washington against March Resources Ltd., Francis J. Mathews, Robert A. Baumgartner, Anthony L. Agostino, Donald G. Charbonneau, and George F. Peters alleging violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5. The defendants, without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations, consented to Final Judgments of Permanent Injunction, which were entered on March 1, enjoining them from violating the antifraud provisions.

The complaint alleges that from about June 1980 to at least May 1981, the defendants, directly and indirectly, singly and in concert, engaged in course of conduct to induce persons in the United States to purchase March securities and to manipulate the price of March's common stock. As a result of these activities, the Commission alleged that the price of March's common stock increased from \$1.10 in June 1980 to \$27 in May 1981, after a two-for-one stock split. During this time, March had almost no reported earnings. (SEC v. March Resources Ltd., et al., USDC WDWA, Civil Action No. 85-C326). (LR-10691)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued extending until May 1 the authorization of Georgia Power Company, subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to issue and sell up to \$50 million of preferred stock. Jurisdiction has been reserved over the fees and expenses related to the sale of the preferred stock. (Rel. 35-23617 - March 1)

GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORP.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 25 to request a hearing on a proposal by General Public Utilities Corp. (GPU), a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Jersey Central Power & Light Company (JCP&L), Metropolitan Edison Company (Met-Ed), and Pennsylvania Electric Company (Penelec). The subsidiaries will issue, sell and renew their respective short-term promissory notes (New Notes) from time to time through March 31, 1987 under a revolving credit agreement (Agreement). Met-Ed's obligations under the Agreement are secured by security interests in \$40 million of its first mortgage bonds, due March 31, 1987, its accounts receivable from the sale of electricity, and its coal inventories. JCP&L, Met-Ed, Penelec and GPU further request authority to issue or renew their respective unsecured promissory notes, from time to time through March 31, 1987, to banks under formal lines of credit (Notes). The total principal amount of Notes outstanding at any one time plus the total principal amount of New Notes then outstanding will not exceed \$375 million. (Rel. 35-23618 - March 1)

MIDDLE SOUTH ENERGY, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 25 to request a hearing on a proposal by Middle South Energy, Inc. (MSE), subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to enter into one or more agreements through December 31, 1985 to make fixed interest rate payments on a certain amount of an outstanding loan agreement debt of \$378 million. MSE would receive floating interest rate payments on the same amount from a counterparty. (Rel. 35-23619 - March 1)

SALOMON BROTHERS MORTGAGE SECURITIES II, INC.

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by Salomon Brothers Mortgage Securities II, Inc. that the trusteeship of Texas Commerce Bank National Association (TCB) under two supplemental indentures of Salomon Brothers is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify TCB from acting as trustee.
