ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

RFG OPTIONS COMPANY, OTHERS CITED

Administrative Law Judge Ralph Hunter Tracy filed an initial decision ordering that: the registration as a broker-dealer of RFG Options Company be suspended for two weeks; Eugene V. Rintels and Dennis G. Guy each be suspended from association with any broker or dealer for four weeks; and Andor A. Fleischman be suspended from association with any broker or dealer for two weeks.

Judge Tracy found that RFG, wilfully aided and abetted by Rintels, Guy and Fleischman, violated Section 7 of the Securities Exchange Act and Regulations T, U, and X promulgated thereunder by the Federal Reserve Board in that they extended credit and caused their lending banks to extend credit in excess of the margin limitations imposed by Regulations T, U, and X. In addition, Judge Tracy found that RFG, aided and abetted by Rintels, Guy and Fleischman, violated Section 17(a) of the Exchange Act and Rule 17a-4, in that RFG failed to keep copies of certain statements submitted to its lending banks in connection with the obtaining of credit.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

HIRAM WALKER COMMERCIAL PAPER, INC.

An order has been issued exempting Hiram Walker Commercial Paper, Inc. from all provisions of the Investment Company Act so that it may issue and sell its commercial paper and other debt securities and advance the net proceeds of the sale thereof to Hiram Walker Resources Ltd. (Hiram Walker), a Canadian corporation, and certain of Hiram Walker's direct and indirect wholly-owned subsidiaries in the United States. (Rel. IC-14563 - June 6)

SHELTER RESOURCE FUND II

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 1 to request a hearing on an application filed by Shelter Resource Fund II (the Partnership) and its general partners, Shelter Resource Corporation and Wilfred N. Cooper, for an order exempting the Partnership from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-14564 - June 6)

KOENIG TAX-ADVANTAGED LIQUIDITY FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 2 to request a hearing on an application filed by Koenig Tax-Advantaged Liquidity Fund, Inc. requesting an order exempting it from the provisions of Section 19(b) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 19b-1 to permit it to distribute long-term capital gains more than once in any one taxable year. (Rel. IC-14565 - June 7)

UNITED STATES & FOREIGN SECURITIES CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 2 to request a hearing on an application by United States & Foreign Securities Corporation for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-14566 - June 7)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MONONGAHELA POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Monongahela Power Company, The Potomac Edison Company and West Penn Power Company, subsidiaries of Allgheny Power System, Inc., to issue and sell short-term notes to banks and to a commercial paper dealer through December 31, 1986 in a maximum principal amount outstanding at any one time of \$60 million, \$70 million, and \$80 million, respectively. (Rel. 35-23719 - June 7)

OHIO POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued regarding Ohio Power Company (OPCo) and Central Ohio Coal Company (COCCo), subsidiaries of American Electric Power Company, Inc., authorizing repayment of an earlier \$9.12 million cash contribution made by OPCo to COCCo which is not needed. (Rel. 35-23720 - June 7)

CENTRAL POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 1 to request a hearing on a proposal by Central Power and Light Company (CPL), subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, and Monongahela Power Company, The Potomac Edison Company and West Penn Power Company, subsidiaries of Allegheny Power System, Inc., for CPL to sublease 106 gondola railcars from West Penn as agent for itself, Monongahela and Potomac Edison. CPL will pay \$11.17 per day for each railcar under the sublease. (Rel. 35-23721 - June 7)

GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Georgia Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to finance pollution control facilities in an amount not to exceed \$150 million. Jurisdiction has been reserved over additional pollution control financing and/or the issuance and sale of first mortgage bonds in an amount not to exceed \$400 million and the issuance and sale of up to \$100 million of preferred stock. (Rel. 35-23722 - June 7)

ALLEGHENY POWER SYSTEM, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 1 to request a hearing on a proposal by Allegheny Power System, Inc., a registered holding company, and its subsidiaries, Allegheny Power Service Corporation, Monongahela Power Company, the Potomac Edison Company and West Penn Power Company. Allegheny will issue guarantees in the case of the workmen's compensation liabilities of Potomac and West Penn in Pennsylvania and Maryland, respectively, in an aggregate amount of up to \$25 million at any one time through December 31, 1989. (Rel. 35-23723 - June 7)

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

WITHDRAWAL GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of MOVIELAB INCORPORATED to withdraw its common stock, \$.50 par value, from listing and registration on the Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. (Rel. 34-22125)

UNLISTED TRADING SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 27 to comment on the application of the Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. for unlisted trading privileges in one issue which is listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchange and is reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. (Rel. 34-22126)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, proposed rule changes filed by the American Stock Exchange, Inc.: (SR-Amex-85-22) to permit member firms to use, for certain limited purposes, the Instinet terminals placed on the floor of the Amex, in options on over-the-counter stocks. (Rel. 34-22110); and (SR-Amex-85-21) to amend Section 114 of the Amex Company Guide to permit Amex listing of Real Estate Investment Trusts with total operating expenses of up to 2% of their average invested assets in any fiscal year. (Rel. 34-22112)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A rule change filed by the Pacific Securities Depository Trust Company has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposed rule change (SR-PSDTC-85-3) increases PSDTC's charges for providing lists which identify participants for whom PSDTC retains securities in its nominee name. PSDTC's

revised fee schedule imposes new weekly, monthly and quarterly subscription rates and imposes different charges for one time special requests depending on whether the request is for current or past information. (Rel. 34-22111)

APPROVAL PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Midwest Clearing Corporation (SR-MCC-85-3) clarifying its policy governing recovery of interest expenses from participants using MCC's Correspondent Delivery and Collection Service. The proposal also limits the amount a participant delivering securities to a non-participant through that service can be credited for in advance of MCC's receipt of payment from the non-participant. (Rel. 34-22113)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

FIRST CHICAGO CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 1 to request a hearing on an application by First Chicago Corporation under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of Chemical Bank under the following indentures is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify Chemical Bank from acting as trustee: July 1, 1984, under which \$125 million principal amount floating rate subordinated notes are outstanding; and January 15, 1985, under which \$200 million principal amount floating rate subordinated capital notes are outstanding. (Rel. TI-992)

MISCELLANEOUS

500 GRANT STREET ASSOCIATES LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 1 to request a hearing on an application of 500 Grant Street Associates Limited Partnership, under Section 12(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, for an order exempting it from the registration requirements of Section 12(g) of the Exchange Act.
