CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

SETTLEMENT REACHED BETWEEN SEC AND NEAL R. GROSS AND CO., INC.

George G. Kundahl, Executive Director of the Commission, announced that on June 21 a settlement was reached between the Commission and Neal R. Gross and Co., Inc., the Commission's former stenographic reporting contractor. On June 13, 1982, the Commission issued a default against Gross for late and poor quality transcripts. Gross subsequently appealed the default to the Armed Services Board of Contract Appeals, and claimed entitlement to excess performance costs in the amount of \$706,691.66.

Under the terms of the Settlement Agreement, Gross agrees to withdraw its claim for \$706,691.66; the default is rescinded and the contract cancelled as of June 13, 1983; Gross agrees not to bid on any Commission contracts for reporting services for 15 years; and the Commission agrees to return \$25,681 which it had drawn against Gross' performance bond, and \$1,062.01 in incorrectly calculated discounts, plus interest on these amounts. (Appeals of Neal R. Gross and Co., Inc., ASBCA Nos. 28776 and 29982, filed October 26, 1983 and September 7, 1984, respectively). (LR-10810)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

CHARLES J. ASCENZI INDICTED

The Washington Regional Office announced that on June 18 a grand jury in West Palm Beach, Florida named Charles J. Ascenzi of Silverdale, Pennsylvania in a two-count indictment alleging wire fraud and the filing of false documents with a bank having deposits insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation. The indictment alleges that Ascenzi fraudulently obtained \$625,000 from the proceeds of an industrial revenue bond issue by the City of West Memphis, Arkansas for the benefit of Maphis Chapman Corporation of Arkansas. It is alleged that Ascenzi, an officer of Maphis Chapman, represented to the bond trustee that Maphis Chapman had purchased \$625,000 of manufacturing equipment and was entitled to reimbursement from the proceeds of the bond issue when in fact no such equipment had been acquired. Ascenzi was enjoined, by consent, in a civil injunctive action brought by the Commission in 1984 relating to the West Memphis bonds. (U.S. v. Charles J. Ascenzi, USDC SDPL, Criminal No. 85-8079-CR-Judge Paine). (LR-10811)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

FEDERATED FUNDS

An order has been issued on an application filed by the Federated Funds and their respective investment advisers for an order to permit the Federated Funds, as well as future investment companies which may be advised by subsidiaries or affiliates of Federated Investors, Inc. to deposit their cash balances remaining uninvested at the end of each trading day in a single joint account whose daily balance would be used to enter into one or more repurchase agreements in a total amount equal to the aggregate daily balance in the account. UNITED STATES & FOREIGN SECURITIES CORPORATION

An order has been issued declaring that United States & Foreign Securities Corporation has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-14620 - July 5)

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by Southern Company Services, Inc., subsidiary of The Southern Company, to extend its short-term borrowing authority through June 30, 1986.
