CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

IRWIN N. SCHNEIDER ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on August 23 U.S. District Court Judge David N. Edelstein in New York issued a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Irwin N. Schneider, a Long Island, New York attorney, permanently enjoining him from violating the antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

The June 27, 1984 complaint alleged that Schneider, as securities counsel for Cymaticolor Corporation, failed to disclose in Cymaticolor's December 1980 registration statement the payment of finders fees to two individuals in connection with the underwriting of the company's public offering. Schneider consented to the injunction without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations. (SEC v. Cymaticolor Corporation, et al., 84 Civ. 4508 [DNE] SDNY, June 27, 1984). (LR-10849)

SIPC SEEKS APPOINTMENT OF A TRUSTEE

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on August 14 the Securities Investor Protection Corporation (SIPC) filed an application in the case of SEC v. Collins Securities Corporation, et al. (USDC EDAR, W. Div., CA #LR-C-85-280). The application seeks the appointment of a trustee for Collins Securities under the provisions of the Securities Investor Protection Act. A hearing date for the SIPC application has not yet been set. Previously, on April 16, 1985, Collins Securities, without admitting or denying the allegations of the SEC complaint, consented to a preliminary injunction and the appointment of a temporary receiver. (SEC v. Collins Securities Corporation, et al., USDC EDAR W. Div., CA #LR-C-280). (LR-10850)

ARREST WARRANT ISSUED FOR CHAROLETTE GARRITY

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on August 15 Judge Robert A. Grant, U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Indiana, South Bend Division, issued a warrant for the arrest of Indiana resident Charolette Garrity in order to compel her appearance at a hearing to determine whether she is financially able to comply with an April 15 Order of Civil Contempt entered against her. The Order of Civil Contempt directs Garrity to disgorge \$581,810 collected from investors in violation of an August 9, 1984 Temporary Restraining Order and an October 5, 1984 Preliminary Injunction previously entered against her by Judge Grant. The Order of Civil Contempt also provides for Garrity's imprisonment if she fails to make the required disgorgement, and cannot show full or partial compliance is possible.

The arrest warrant was issued after Garrity, in violation of an Order of the above Court, failed to appear at an August 15, 1985 hearing, scheduled to enable her to present evidence in support of her claim that she is financially unable to fully comply with the Order of Civil Contempt. (SEC v. Charolette Garrity, et al., Civil Action No. S84-0484, filed August 9, 1984). (LR-10852)

SUPERIOR CARE, INC. NAMED IN COMPLAINT

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on August 23 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Superior Care, Inc. of Great Neck, New York. The complaint alleges violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws and seeks a judgment of permanent injunction and other equitable relief.

The Commission alleges that Superior, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended March 29, 1985, and its Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for its fiscal quarter ended June 28, 1985, and filed late certain Annual and Quarterly Reports on Forms 10-K and 10-Q. The Commission requests that the Court order Superior to file its delinquent Annual and Quarterly Reports and enjoin it from further violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws. (SEC v. Superior Care, Inc., USDC DC, Civil Action No. 85-2730). (LR-10853)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CONSOLIDATED NATURAL GAS COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 16 to request a hearing on an application-declaration filed by Consolidated Natural Gas Company, a registered holding company, seeking authorization to borrow up to \$100 million under a credit agreement with a group of banks in order to make loans to subsidiary companies for capital expenditures. (Rel. 35-23800 - Aug. 23)

THE SOUTHERN COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 16 to request a hearing on a proposal by The Southern Company, a registered holding company, and a number of its subsidiaries, to issue up to a maximum of \$5 million in value of its authorized but unissued shares of common stock in order to fund the Employee Stock Ownership Plan for the 1984 plan year. (Rel. 35-23801 - Aug. 23)

CENTRAL AND SOUTH WEST CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 16 to request a hearing on a proposal by Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, West Texas Utilities Company (WTU), to extend until June 30, 1986 the authority for WTU to issue up to 300,000 additional shares of its preferred stock, \$100 par value per share. (Rel. 35-23802 - Aug. 23)

COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 16 to request a hearing on a proposal by Columbia Gas System, Inc., a registered holding company, to amend its indenture and thereby place less restrictive terms on capital stock distribution. (Rel. 35-23803 - Aug. 23)

CASTLE & COOKE, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 19 to request a hearing on an application by Castle & Cooke, Inc. requesting an order declaring that it not be an electric utility company. (Rel. 35-23804 - Aug. 26)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-84-13) to change a reference in MSRB Rule G-4 from Commission Rule 19d-3 to Rule 19h-1(d). (Rel. 34-22351); The Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-PSE-85-20) to create 11 new specialist posts on the PSE equity trading floor. (Rel. 34-22352); and The Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-85-13) to provide for the issuance, clearance and settlement of foreign currency options to be traded on the proposed link between the Philadelphia Stock Exchange and the London Stock Exchange.
