# **RULES AND RELATED MATTERS**

AMENDMENTS TO RULE 17f-5 ADOPTED

The Commission adopted amendments to Rule 17f-5 under the Investment Company Act of 1940, which permits registered U.S. and Canadian investment companies to make foreign custody arrangements under certain conditions. The amendments clarify the rule with respect to the extent to which investment companies are required to monitor the eligibility of their foreign custodians under the rule. The amendments also provide that when an existing custodial arrangement no longer complies with the rule, an investment company will have a period of time in which to make alternative arrangements. ## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST LOUIS R. TRUJILLO

The San Francisco Branch Office announced that public administrative proceedings have been instituted against Louis R. Trujillo, formerly administrative manager of the San Francisco office of Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith, Inc.

The Order for Proceedings alleges that Trujillo failed reasonably to supervise Victor G. Matl, formerly a registered representative in Merrill Lynch's San Francisco office.

In a related proceeding instituted earlier, the Commission issued an Order which accepted Offers of Settlement from Matl, Merrill Lynch and Robert M. Fisher, formerly office manager of Merrill Lynch's San Francisco office. Pursuant to the settlements, the Commission made findings that Matl had violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws by making misrepresentations of material facts, recommendations unsuitable and excessive transactions and effecting transactions beyond the scope of authority granted by his customers. The Commission also found that Fisher and Merrill Lynch failed reasonably to supervise Matl, with a view to preventing his violations.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations are true and whether any remedial actions should be taken by the Commission. (Rel. 34-22394)

ORDER INSTITUTING PROCEEDINGS AND IMPOSING REMEDIAL SANCTIONS AGAINST MERRILL LYNCH, PIERCE, FENNER & SMITH, INC., OTHERS

The San Francisco Branch Office announced that public administrative proceedings have been instituted against Merrill Lynch, Pierce, Fenner & Smith, Inc., a registered broker-dealer, Robert M. Fisher and Victor G. Matl, formerly office manager and registered representative of Merrill Lynch's San Francisco, California office, respectively.

Simultaneously with the institution of the proceedings, the Commission accepted Offers of Settlement submitted by Merrill Lynch, Fisher and Matl. Without admitting or denying the violations alleged, Merrill Lynch, Fisher and Matl consented to an Order finding that Matl violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws and that Merrill Lynch and Fisher failed reasonably to supervise Matl.

The Commission ordered that: (1) Matl be barred from association in any capacity with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer; (2) Merrill Lynch be censured and comply with certain undertakings to adopt or maintain procedures; and (3) Fisher be suspended from association with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser or municipal securities dealer for a period of time and that he be retrained in certain compliance procedures. ## **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

### METROPOLITAN TOWER LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 4 to request a hearing on an application by Metropolitan Tower Life Insurance Company, et al., requesting an amendment to a previous exemptive order to exempt Applicants from Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a) and 15(b) of the Investment Company Act to permit the same funding medium to be used for both scheduled and flexible premium variable life insurance policies. The application also requests an exemptive order from Rule 6e-3(T)(c)(1) to permit allocations of amounts provided for investment under flexible premium variable life insurance policies to be allocated to the sponsoring insurance company's general account. ### PROVIDENTMUTUAL VARIABLE LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 2 to request a hearing on an application by Providentmutual Variable Life Insurance Company, et al., for an order: (1) for an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act to permit Applicants to reorganize separate accounts offering variable life insurance; (2) to permit the reorganization; (3) to exempt certain life insurance companies and variable life insurance separate accounts from Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a) and 15(b) and Rule 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) to permit mixed funding and shared funding; and (4) to exempt Applicants from Sections 26(a) and 27(c)(2) to permit the deduction of the cost of insurance in the variable life insurance policies.
