REVISION OF SECTION 200.80e APPENDIX E

The Commission will revise Section 200.80e Appendix E, which sets forth the schedule of fees for records and services and designates the service contractor to provide copies of public documents filed with the Commission. On May 20, the Commission awarded a contract for microfilm production and dissemination of the Commission's public documents to Bechtel Information Services. Bechtel began providing these services October 1. This rule change designates Bechtel to replace the prior contractor, Disclosure Partners, and reflects changes in the fees charged for services. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
