ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

ROURKE O'BRIEN SUSPENDED

The Commission accepted the Offer of Settlement of Rourke O'Brien of Bellevue, Washington in which he consented to findings that he wilfully violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws. O'Brien also consented to a four-month suspension from association with any broker or dealer and a bar from association with any broker or dealer in a supervisory or proprietary capacity. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CREDIT LYONNAIS CANADA

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 3 to request a hearing on an application of Credit Lyonnais Canada, a Canadian chartered bank which presently proposes to make an offering of commercial paper in the United States, for an order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. POST-OCH KREDITBANKEN, PKBANKEN

An order has been issued exempting Post-och Kreditbanken, PKbanken, a Swedish commercial bank, and its subsidiary, PKbanken Finance Corporation, a Delaware corporation, from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-13712 - Jan. 10)

CAPITAL REALTY INVESTORS-III LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

An order has been issued exempting Capital Realty Investors-III Limited Partnership, et al. from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-13713 - Jan. 10)

MERRILL LYNCH FUND FOR TOMORROW, INC.

An order has been issued exempting Merrill Lynch Fund For Tomorrow, Inc. from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 2(a)(35), 22(c) and 22(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 22c-1. This will permit Merrill to assess a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of its shares and to waive the contingent deferred sales charge respecting certain types of redemptions. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rule changes filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Pacific Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-PSE-83-20) to prohibit non-member broker-dealers as well as members from placing proprietary orders with options Order Book Officials. (Rel. 34-20544); The Philadelphia Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-Phlx-83-20) to revise its rules describing the qualifications for Foreign Currency Options Principals and to designate persons eligible to solicit or accept foreign currency option orders as "account executives" rather than "registered representatives". (Rel. 34-20545); and The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated (SR-CBOE-83-37) to permit delisting of options series in which there is no open interest. (Rel. 34-20546)

NOTICE OF EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A rule change filed by the Options Clearing Corporation has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposed rule change (SR-OCC-83-23) contains a credit and security agreement between OCC and the Bank of America relating to the settlement of foreign currency options. (Rel. 34-20547)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change (SR-NASD-83-20) to amend Section 13 of Schedule E of the NASD's By-Laws to clarify that the term "affiliate" used in Section 13 is one that is subject to Section 9 of Schedule E, to impose a six-month holding period on securities purchased under Section 13, and to clarify that directors are entitled to purchase securities under Section 13. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of January 9. (Rel. 34-20548)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

DOW CORNING CORPORATION

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application of Dow Corning Corporation that the trusteeship of Citibank, N.A., under an indenture previously qualified under the Act, and an indenture that has not been qualified under the Act, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify Citibank from acting as trustee.
