NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

CHANGE IN THE MEETING: RESCHEDULING

The closed meeting scheduled for Tuesday, April 17, at 10:00 a.m. has been changed to Wednesday, April 18, at 10:00 a.m.

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

DANIEL R. WALTERS PLEADS GUILTY

Robert N. Miller, U.S. Attorney for the District of Colorado, and the Denver Regional Office announced that on March 16 Daniel R. Walters entered a plea of guilty before Judge Richard Matsch, U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado. Walters pleaded guilty to a one-count information charging him with violating 26 U.S.C. §7206(1) by filing a false income tax return for tax year 1980, which return failed to report profits earned from stock sales in nominee accounts in which Walters had an interest. During this period of time, Walters owned an interest in OTC Net, Inc., a former Denver-based broker-dealer currently in SIPC liquidation. (U.S. v. Daniel R. Walters, U.S.D.C. Colorado, Criminal Action No. 84-CR-41). (LR-10337)

INDICTMENT DISMISSED

Robert N. Miller, U.S. Attorney for the District of Colorado, and the Denver Regional Office announced that on March 23 Judge Richard Matsch, U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado, entered an order dismissing a seven-count indictment returned October 19, 1983 charging Joseph V. Pignatiello, Juan Carlos Schidlowski, and Arlan I. Preblud with securities fraud, conspiracy, and mail fraud, and Pignatiello with filing a false tax return. Judge Matsch dismissed the indictment based on his finding that an unauthorized person had appeared before the Grand Jury which returned the indictment, such appearance being in violation of Rule 6(d), Fed. R. Crim. P.

Judge Matsch found that the Department of Justice had, by letter dated August 23, 1982, appointed a Commission attorney to act as a Special Assistant U.S. Attorney in the criminal matter; that the Commission attorney appeared before the Grand Jury on August 24, 1982 without having been administered the appropriate oath of office; and that such appearance constituted a violation of Rule 6(d). (U.S. v. Joseph V. Pignatiello, et al., U.S.D.C. Colo., Criminal Action No. 83-CR-334). (LR-10338)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

T. ROWE PRICE NEW INCOME FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 7 to request a hearing on an application of T. Rowe Price New Income Fund, Inc., other T. A proposed rule change filed by The Options Clearing Corporation has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-OCC-84-3) specifies the "unit of trading" for options on the French franc and makes certain technical changes in OCC's By-Laws related to foreign currency options. (Rel. 34-20848)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
