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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### RICHARD G. KETCHUM APPOINTED DIRECTOR OF MARKET REGULATION

Chairman John S.R. Shad appointed Richard G. Ketchum as Director of the Division of Market Regulation. Mr. Ketchum succeeds Douglas Scarff, who has returned to private practice of law. Mr. Ketchum has been Associate Director of the Division since 1981.

Mr. Ketchum, 33, joined the Commission as a staff attorney in the Division of Market Regulation in 1977. After participating in the Special Study of the Options Markets, he was named Branch Chief and then Assistant Director of the Office of Self-Regulatory Organizations and National Market System; in 1981 he was appointed Associate Director.

Mr. Ketchum received B.A. and J.D. degrees from Tufts University and New York University School of Law, respectively. He is an adjunct professor in Securities Regulation at the American University School of Law. Before joining the Commission, he was associated with a New York City law firm.

### THREE NEW APPOINTMENTS MADE IN CORPORATION FINANCE

John J. Huber, Director of the Division of Corporation Finance, today announced three new appointments in the Division.

Catherine Collins McCoy has been appointed Associate Director (Legal). Ms. McCoy will have responsibility for the Office of Disclosure Policy, which is the Division's primary rulemaking office, and the Office of Chief Counsel, with the Division's legal interpretive, legislative and calendar responsibilities. Ms. McCoy joined the Commission staff in 1975 serving in the Division of Corporation Finance for most of that time and the Office of General Counsel from 1978 to 1979. Since 1979, she has served in positions of increasing responsibility for the Division's rulemaking activities. Ms. McCoy received her J.D. degree from the Washington College of Law of American University in 1977.

Amy L. Goodman has been appointed Associate Director (EDGAR). In that position, Ms. Goodman has responsibility for the development of the electronic system for the filing, review and dissemination of corporate disclosure documents filed with the Commission. Ms. Goodman, who joined the Commission staff in 1975 after graduation from Boston University Law School, served in responsible positions in the Division of Investment Management and the Office of the Chairman before moving to the Division of Corporation Finance in December 1979. Ms. Goodman earned an LL.M. degree from Georgetown University Law Center in 1981.

Jo Ann L. Zuercher has been appointed Chief of the Office of Disclosure Policy. Ms. Zuercher brings to the Division's rulemaking office the knowledge and perspective gained as a staff attorney in the Division of Market Regulation beginning in 1979, later as a staff attorney in the Division of Corporation Finance and most recently as Special Counsel to Chairman John S.R. Shad. Ms. Zuercher received her J.D. degree from Tulane University School of Law in January 1979.

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Rule changes have become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 by: The National Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-NSCC-84-11) which amends NSCC's suggested name match procedure to provide that with respect to trade input where at least one of the two parties names as the contra party an omnibus account, as specified by NSCC, in cases where the purchaser and seller have submitted identical data except for the number of shares traded and the names of the contra party, the transaction will be deemed partially compared to the extent of the lesser number of shares submitted. (Rel. 34-21041); and The Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-84-10) amends Interpretation and Policy .05 of OCC Rule 604 to require U.S. and non-U.S. institutions applying for OCC approval to issue letters of credit for OCC margin purposes to provide OCC with quarterly financial reports, published or otherwise, in certain circumstances. ### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rule changes by: The Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-84-8) relating to reclamations of inter-dealer deliveries of municipal securities. (Rel. 34-21054); and The Midwest Securities Trust Company (SR-MSTC-84-4) that would amend MSTC's By-laws to increase the number of MSTC directors from 17 to 18. (Rel. 34-21057)

### TEMPORARY ACCELERATED APPROVAL

The Commission approved, on a temporary accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by the American Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-Amex-84-14) to implement its AUTOPER ODD-LOT system. (Rel. 34-21058)
