COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

NEW CHIEF ACCOUNTANT NAMED IN DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT

The Commission today announced that Robert J. Sack will become Chief Accountant in the Division of Enforcement effective in late August. Mr. Sack will succeed L. Glenn Perry, who is joining Peat, Marwick, Mitchell & Co. as a partner in its executive office in New York.

Mr. Sack has been with Touche Ross & Co., an independent accounting firm, since 1958, and has been a partner in that firm since 1970. His responsibilities with Touche Ross & Co. have included auditing and supervision of professional standards, professional practices and audit operation for both domestic and international activities. From 1979 to 1981, Mr. Sack was Touche Ross & Co.'s National Director of Professional Practice. From 1981 to the present, he was Director of Audit Operations for Touche Ross & Co.'s Northeast Ohio Office.

Mr. Sack is a 1956 graduate of Miami University in Ohio.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

HARRY POOLE BARRED

The Commission barred Harry Poole of Doylestown, Pennsylvania, formerly a registered representative with Selheimer & Company, from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer. After one year, Poole may apply to become reassociated in a non-proprietary, non-supervisory capacity upon a showing that he will be properly supervised. The simultaneously instituted and settled public administrative proceedings involved Poole's alleged violation of the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 by selling unregistered stock of World Gambling Corporation. Poole, without admitting or denying he violated the securities laws, consented to findings by the Commission that: (1) a final judgment of permanent injunction was entered against him on August 26, 1982, prohibiting him from violating the registration provisions of the Securities Act [SEC v. World Gambling Corporation, et al., 82 Civ. 3821, SDNY, aff'd as to Lewis Scala, No. 83-6102, 2d Cir., October 27, 1983]; and (2) he wilfully violated the registration provisions of the Securities Act. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER ISSUED AGAINST JJ PETROLEUM, OTHERS

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on July 25 Judge Tom Stagg, U.S. District Court for the Western District of Louisiana, issued an order temporarily restraining JJ Petroleum, R&A Resources, Inc., also known as R&A Resources, Dannyco Oil and Gas Properties, Inc., John O. Robinson and Jewell K. Allen, all of Shreveport, Louisiana. The order, which expired August 4, 1984, restrained them from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

The July 24 complaint alleges that the defendants violated the registration provisions of the securities laws by offering and selling securities to the public in the form of fractional undivided working interests in oil and gas wells located in Louisiana, raising over \$1 million. In connection with these offers and sales, the complaint alleged that the defendants made fraudulent representations to investors concerning the wells' productivity and status, use of investors' money, lack of production and other matters. (SEC v. JJ Petroleum, et al., Civil Action File No. CV 84-1948, WD LA, July 25, 1984). (LR-10480)

TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER ISSUED AGAINST PEGGY D. STINES

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on August 2 Judge Jerry Buchmeyer, U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas, issued an order temporarily restraining Peggy D. Stines, individually and doing business as Garland Film Buyers Group and North Texas Film Processors, Inc., from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. Judge Buchmeyer also appointed Richard M. Hull, Esq. of Dallas, Texas as Temporary Receiver for Garland Film and North Texas Film.

The August 2 complaint alleges that: Stines offered and sold unregistered securities in the form of investment contracts providing for a guaranteed return to the investor from the extraction of silver from photographic film; Stines made misrepresentations and omissions of material fact concerning the source of money used to pay returns, profitability, and commingling of funds; Stines misappropriated investors' funds; and at least \$10 million was raised from over 400 investors. (SEC v. Peggy D. Stines, individually and d/b/a Garland Film Buyers Group and North Texas Film Processors, Inc., Civil Action File No. CA-3-84-1277 R, ND TX, August 2, 1984). (LR-10481)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MUTUAL OF AMERICA LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 30 to request a hearing on an application filed by Mutual of America Life Insurance Company and Mutual of America Separate Account No. 2 for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 17(f) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17f-2 in the sale of certain variable annuity contracts. CAPITAL SOUTHWEST CORPORATION

An order has been issued granting Capital Southwest Corporation (CSC), a registered closed-end, non-diversified, management investment company, exemptions from Sections 18(d) and 23(a) and (b) of the Investment Company Act, and permitting certain transactions, all in connection with the proposed adoption by CSC of a stock option plan. (Rel. IC-14086 - Aug. 7)

HAMMOND GNMA SECURITIES CORPORATION

An order has been issued exempting Hammond GNMA Securities Corporation and Hammond Mortgage Securities Corporation from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-14087 - Aug. 7)

NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until September 4 to request a hearing on a proposal by New England Electric System, a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to 500,000 common shares through December 31, 1988 under a system Goals Plan. (Rel. 35-23388 - Aug. 8)

GEORGIA POWER COMPANY
