## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### NETELKOS AND GAMAREKIAN ENJOINED

The New York Regional Office announced that on August 3 Judge Shirley Wohl Kram, Southern District of New York, issued an opinion and order preliminarily enjoining Christos Netelkos, also known as Christopher Nickos, and Charles Haig Gamarekian, also known as Charles Haig, from violations of the securities laws, including Sections 5(a) and (c) of the Securities Act, and Sections 10(b), 17A(c) and 17A(d) of the Securities Exchange Act. The Court also ordered that Netelkos's assets be frozen except for a \$100 per day living expense.

The Court found that Netelkos and Gamarekian: in 1982 and 1983, while secretly controlling Falcon Sciences, Inc., sold approximately three million unauthorized and "probably counterfeit" Falcon shares through 11 Swiss branches of American brokerage firms and two U.S.-based broker-dealers, in violation of the securities laws, for a \$3.4 million profit; defrauded the investing public by failing to disclose their prior criminal and civil records of securities law violations, their control of Falcon, their real names, and that much of Falcon's income, reported as oil and gas revenue, was actually illegal stock sales proceeds; and caused Falcon to violate the public filing, transfer agent registration and transfer agent recordkeeping provisions of the securities laws. ### LIBERTY HOUSING PARTNERS LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

An order has been issued on an application of Liberty Housing Partners Limited Partnership (Partnership) and its managing general partner, Liberty Real Estate Corporation, exempting the Partnership from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-14097 - Aug. 14)

OHIO NATIONAL FUND, INC.
