DECISIONS IN ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING

COTZIN BARRED. The Commission has issued an order barring Sumner B. Cotzin of Worcester, Massachusetts, from engaging in, or associating with any person engaged in, the business of a broker-dealer, investment adviser or registered investment company. Cotzin, as a sole-proprietor, is registered as a broker-dealer and is a general partner in another registered broker-dealer.

The Commission found that during the period 1969 to 1972, respondent violated the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws in connection with the offer and sale of unregistered warrants of Paradox Production Corp., and antifraud and escrow provisions in connection with the offer and sale of securities of May Lee Import-Export Corporation. It was also found that he violated net capital, credit extension and recordkeeping requirements. In February 1972 he had been permanently enjoined from violations of the above provisions.

Respondent consented to the findings and sanctions without admitting or denying the allegations in the order for proceedings. (Rel. 34-10132)

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

TRADING SUSPENDED IN TWELVE COMPANIES. The SEC has ordered the temporary suspension of over-the-counter trading in the securities of Penn-Tech Corporation, Redwood City, California; Dalto Electronics Corp., Norwood, New Jersey; Automation Sciences Inc., New York, New York; Inland Systems Inc., Springfield, Ohio; American Land Company, Virginia Beach, Virginia; Applied Synthetics Corp., East St. Louis, Illinois; Pyramid Communications, Inc., New York, New York; First Small Business Investment Company of Tampa, Inc., New York, New York; Illinois Capital Investment Corporation, Chicago, Illinois; Scientific Incineration Devices, Inc., Cedar Grove, New Jersey; Gourdine Systems Inc., Livingston, New Jersey; and Scotco Data Com, Inc., Woodbridge, Connecticut for one ten-day period commencing on May 7 and terminating at midnight (EDT) on May 16, 1973.

The Commission ordered the suspension of trading because of the lack of adequate and accurate public information concerning these companies which have failed to timely and properly file certain annual and quarterly reports with the Commission on Forms N-1R, 10-K, and 10-Q as required by the provisions of the Exchange Act and the Investment Company Act of 1940. FOREIGN RESTRICTED LIST. The Commission on May 4, 1973, placed Caye Chapel Club, Ltd. on the Foreign Restricted List. This is a corporation organized under the laws of British Honduras for the purpose of developing an island resort facility including a gambling casino. The shares of this company are being publicly offered without registration under the Securities Act of 1933, in violation of the provisions of Section 5 of that statute. (Rel. 33-5390)

COURT ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS

TRUSTEE NAMED FOR P & H ASSOCIATES. The SEC New York Regional Office announced that on April 17 the Federal court in New York appointed Edward Brodsky as SIPC trustee for P & H Associates, New York, New York. P & H Associates by its general partners Thomas Herman and Ronald Pilatsky consented to the entry of the order. (LR-5876)

COMPLAINT NAMES SCHREIBER BOSSE & CO., INC., OTHERS. The SEC Chicago Regional Office announced that on May 1 a complaint was filed in the Federal court in Cleveland, Ohio charging Schreiber Bosse & Co., Inc., aided and abetted by Richard Schreiber, President, and Thomas Bosse, Chairman of the Board, with violations of the net capital, bookkeeping and supplemental financial reporting rules of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. AMERICAN PATRIOTS FUND. The SEC has issued a notice giving interested persons until May 29 to request a hearing on an application filed by American Patriots Fund, Inc., of Walnut Creek, California, for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-7803)

F-D CAPITAL FUND. The SEC has issued an order on an application filed by F-D Capital Fund, of Boston, Massachusetts, declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-7804)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MISSISSIPPI POWER COMPANY. The SEC has issued an order authorizing Mississippi Power Company, Atlanta subsidiary of The Southern Company, to (1) issue and sell \$1,473,000 amount of first mortgage bonds, 2-3/4% Series due 1980, and to surrender such bonds for sinking fund purposes and (2) issue and sell \$15,000,000 of first mortgage bonds at competitive bidding. The sinking fund bonds will be issued on the basis of unfunded net property additions and will not constitute a liability of Mississippi. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds sold at competitive bidding, along with other funds, will be applied toward Mississippi's 1973 construction program (estimated at \$43,701,000) and will be used to repay short-term promissory notes. (Rel. 35-17955)

JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY. The SEC has issued an order authorizing Jersey Central Power & Light Company, Morristown subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, to extend from June 30, 1973, to December 31, 1973, the period during which Jersey Central may issue and sell its short-term notes to a group of banks in an amount outstanding at any one time of not in excess of \$66,000,000. (Rel. 35-17956)
