ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

CEASE AND DESIST ORDER ENTERED AGAINST KUSLIMA SHOGEN, STANISLAW MIKULSKI, AND ALLEN SIEGEL

On March 3, the Commission issued an Order pursuant to Section 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) against Kuslima Shogen (Shogen), Stanislaw Mikulski (Mikulski), and Allen Siegel (Siegel), requiring Shogen to cease and desist from committing or causing any violations or future violations of Sections 13(d), 13(g) and 16(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 13d-1, 13d-2, 16a-2 and 16a-3 promulgated thereunder; Mikulski to cease and desist from committing or causing any violations or future violations of Sections 13(d) and 16(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 13d-1, 13d-2, 16a-2 and 16a-3 promulgated thereunder; and Siegel to cease and desist from committing or causing any violations or future violations of Section 16(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 16a-2 and 16a-3 promulgated thereunder. Shogen is the Chairman of the Board of Directors of Alfacell Corporation (Alfacell), and Chief Executive Officer, director and beneficial owner of more than ten percent of the equity securities of Alfacell. Mikulski is an Executive Vice President, director and a former beneficial owner of more than five percent of the equity securities of Alfacell. Siegel is a former director of Alfacell. The shares of Alfacell are quoted on the Nasdaq Small Cap Market. The respondents, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's Order, consented to the entry of the Order finding that with respect to beneficial ownership of the equity securities of Alfacell: (1) Shogen failed to file a Schedule 13D and 13G and thirty-six amendments thereto, did not timely file a Form 3, sixty-seven Forms 4 and three Forms 5 in transactions worth more than \$6.9 million; (2) Mikulski failed to file a Schedule 13D and fifteen amendments thereto, and did not timely file a Form 3, twenty-six Forms 4 and three Forms 5 in transactions worth more than \$6.9 million; and (3) Siegel did not timely file a Form 3, forty-two Forms 4 and four Forms 5 in transactions worth more than \$5.6 million.

Simultaneously with the entry of the Commission's Order, the Commission filed a civil action pursuant to Section 21(d)(3) of the Exchange Act seeking from (1) Shogen a civil penalty of \$20,000, and

(2) Mikulski and Siegel a civil penalty of \$10,000 each. Without admitting or denying the Commission's allegations, the defendants consented to entry of a final judgment imposing the penalties. SEC v. HURST CAPITAL CORPORATION, ET AL.

The Commission announced that on February 27, 1998, the Honorable Daniel T.K. Hurley, United States District Judge for the Southern District of Florida continued the emergency Orders he had entered on February 18, 1998 against Hurst Capital Corp. (HCC), a West Palm Beach company that sells interests in accounts receivable. Specifically, Judge Hurley preliminarily enjoined defendants HCC, James F. Hurst and E. William Clifton from violating the securities laws, froze their assets and those of four corporations they control, and authorized the previously appointed Receiver for HCC, Kenneth A. Welt, to continue to marshal assets. All defendants either consented or did not object to the entry of these orders. At the hearing before Judge Hurley, the SEC announced that it had frozen approximately \$16.5 million in funds.

In its complaint and application to the Court for a temporary restraining order, asset freeze and appointment of a receiver, all of which the Court granted on February 18, 1998 and extended on February 27, 1998, the SEC alleged that HCC had raised \$49 million from 1300 investors across the nation to buy accounts receivable but that it had only purchased approximately \$625,000 worth of receivables. INSTITUTION AND SETTLEMENT OF CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTIONS AGAINST ROBERT PELTZ, SOL GREENBAUM AND DAVID COHEN

The Commission filed and simultaneously settled civil actions in federal court against Robert B. Peltz, Sol Greenbaum and David Cohen alleging securities law violations arising out of a fraudulent scheme to overstate the revenues and earnings of the Peltz Food Division of Chipwich, Inc. Each of the defendants, without admitting or denying the SEC's allegations, consented to the entry of final judgments against them.

The complaint against Robert Peltz alleges that in February 1989, he merged his privately-owned Peltz Food Company, a distributor of frozen foods, into Chipwich, a public company, and became CEO and chairman of Chipwich. At year-end in 1989, 1990 and 1991, with Peltz's knowledge and approval, the Peltz Food Division (PFD) of Chipwich overstated its inventory, causing Chipwich to materially overstate its inventory and net income. In addition, during the relevant period, Peltz misappropriated corporate funds to pay personal expenses and took unrecorded cash from PFD's daily cash receipts.

The complaint against Sol Greenbaum and David Cohen, the CPAs who prepared PFD's financial statements and acted as its financial management, alleges that they knew or were reckless in not knowing of the inventory inflation and misappropriation of cash at PFD. In addition, the complaint alleges that they knew or were reckless in not knowing that the financial statements they prepared for PFD were materially false and misleading and would be relied upon by Chipwich in preparing financial statements for dissemination in its Forms 10-K and 10-Q.

The judgment against Peltz permanently bars him from serving as an officer or director of any reporting company and enjoins him from further violations of the applicable antifraud, reporting and internal controls provisions of the securities laws. The judgment against Greenbaum and Cohen enjoins them from further violations of the applicable antifraud, reporting, record-keeping and internal control provisions of the securities laws. [SEC v. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ST. CLAIR FUNDS, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by St. Clair Funds, Inc. (Company) and Munder Capital Management (Adviser). Applicants seek an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a) and 15(b) Act and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) thereunder to the extent necessary to permit shares of any current or future series of the Company and shares of any other investment company that is designed to fund variable insurance products and for which the Adviser, or any of its affiliates, may serve now or in the future as investment adviser, administrator, manager, principal underwriter or sponsor, to be offered and sold to, and held by variable annuity and variable life insurance separate accounts of both affiliated and unaffiliated life insurance companies and qualified pension and retirement plans outside of the separate account context. CYPRESSTREE ASSET MANAGEMENT CORPORATION, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by CypressTree Asset Management Corporation, et al. under Sections 6(c) and 23(c) of the Investment Company Act. The order would exempt a registered closed-end management investment company from certain provisions of Rule 23c-3 under the Act to permit it to make repurchase offers on a monthly basis. (Rel. SBSF FUNDS, INC. D/B/A KEY MUTUAL FUNDS, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by SBSF Funds, Inc. d/b/a Key Mutual Funds, et al. under Section 17(b) of the Investment Company Act. The order permits certain series of a registered open-end management investment company to acquire all of the assets and assume all of the liabilities of certain series of another registered open-end management investment company. (Rel. IC-23056 - March 3)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change filed by the Boston Stock Exchange (SR-BSE-98-02) to amend its fee schedule pertaining to Floor Operation Fees has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 9. (Rel. 34-39705)

A proposed rule change filed by the American Stock Exchange (SR-AMEX-98-07) to extend the permissible maturity of FLEX equity options has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of March 9. (Rel. 34-39706)
