ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

IAN AND LAWRENCE FISHMAN ORDERED TO CEASE AND DESIST

On June 24, the Commission instituted a settled cease and desist proceeding against Ian and Lawrence Fishman, which finds that on January 27 and 28, 1997, on five occasions, the Fishmans knowingly engaged in a series of transactions designed to increase and decrease the National Best Bid or Offer quotes (NBBO) for five securities subject to the newly effective Limit Order Display Rule, Rule 11Ac-4 under the Exchange Act (Display Rule) and to trade at those affected prices. Pursuant to the Display Rule, market makers are required to display customer limit orders that are priced better than the market maker's quote for the same stock. If the customer's order is also better than the NBBO, it is incorporated into the NBBO, irrespective of the size of the order.

The Order states that the Fishmans engaged in a coordinated effort using Ian Fishman's limit orders to move the public bid or offer quote, in order to permit Lawrence Fishman to buy or sell a security at a price that otherwise would not have been available in the market. The Order states that the investing public and other market participants, including broker-dealers who rely on the integrity of the NBBO, were unaware that the NBBO quotes altered as a result of Ian Fishman's orders, reflected not genuine market activity, but the Fishmans' coordinated actions. Accordingly, the Commission found that the Fishmans violated the antifraud provisions, Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. Without admitting or denying the allegations in the Order, Ian and Lawrence Fishman consented to cease and desist from committing or causing any violations of these provisions, and Lawrence Fishman has consented to pay disgorgement and prejudgment interest on their illicit profits. COURT GRANTS EMERGENCY ORDERS IN "PRIME BANK" SECURITIES SCHEME

On June 22, the United States District Court for the Northern District of Texas granted the Commission's request for an order freezing the assets of Lennox Investment Group, Ltd. (Lennox), Active International, Inc. (Active), Randall W. Randall W. Law, James F. Wardell, Monica M. Iles, Frank L. Peitz, and Daniel B. Benson, and relief defendants P.B.F. Capital Corp, Inc., Benson Financial, Inc., Robert Paladino, People's Residential Mortgage Corp., Benny Griffis, and L. E. Consultant Company. Additionally, the Court ordered all defendants to account for investor monies and to repatriate any funds not subject to the jurisdiction of the Court, and ordered the appointment of a receiver to take control of the assets of the defendants for the benefit of investors.

According to the Commission's complaint, Lennox, Active, Law, Wardell, Iles, Peitz and Benson raised approximately \$11.1 million from more than 50 investors in at least 10 states through the fraudulent offer and sale of unregistered "prime bank" securities. Investors were told that their funds would be placed in an escrow account, with the investment principal guaranteed, and that their funds would be invested in a trading program where investors could expect a yield of 122.5% per week for 40 weeks during the 54 week term of the program. In fact, according to the complaint, the trading program did not exist and these defendants, instead of investing the funds, stole the entire \$11.1 million of investors' funds which were disbursed for the benefit of themselves and their designees, including the relief defendants. The complaint further requests orders preliminarily and permanently enjoining Lennox, Active, Law, Wardell, Iles, Peitz and Benson from future violations of the federal securities laws. [SEC v. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE LIPPER FUNDS, INC., ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until July 17, 1998, to request a hearing on an application filed by The Lipper Funds, Inc. (Company), et al. for an order under Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting applicants from Section 15(f)(1)(A). The order would permit a former director of the Company to rejoin the Company's board of directors. (Rel. IC-23263 - June 22)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change submitted by NASD Regulation (SR-NASD-98-28) amending Rule 2210 of the Conduct Rules of the National Association of Securities Dealers to permit the approval of certain research reports by a supervisory analyst approved by the New York Stock Exchange to satisfy NASD requirements that research reports to be approved by a registered principal. Publication of the approval of the proposed rule change is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 29. (Rel. 34-40105)

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change (SR-PCX-98-14) filed by the Pacific Exchange relating to the ninety-day extension of a Supervisory Specialist Pilot Program. Publication of the order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 29. (Rel. 34-40108)

EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY REGISTRATION AS A CLEARING AGENCY

Delta Clearing Corp. filed pursuant to Section 19(a) of the Securities Exchange Act a request for extension of its registration as a clearing agency under Section 17A of the Act. The Commission has extended such temporary approval through July 31, 1999. Publication of the notice and order is expected in the Federal Register during the week of June 29. (Rel. 34-40112)
