COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

MARY TOKAR, SENIOR ASSOCIATE CHIEF ACCOUNTANT IN THE OFFICE OF THE CHIEF ACCOUNTANT, TO LEAVE SEC

Mary B. Tokar, Senior Associate Chief Accountant, International, in the Securities and Exchange Commission's Office of the Chief Accountant, announced today that she is leaving the Commission to become a partner in the accounting firm of KPMG. Ms. Tokar will join KPMG's national office in New York before transferring to the firm's international accounting and reporting practice in London next year. A successor has not been named.

SEC Chairman Arthur Levitt said, "Mary has played an important role in the Commission's efforts to foster international accounting standards and forge significant regulatory and accounting agreements with our international counterparts. Mary's wise counsel, ambassadorial skills, unflappable demeanor, and wonderful spirit have served me, the Commission, and investors well. I wish her great continued success."

SEC Chief Accountant Lynn E. Turner said, "Mary has been one of the most significant players contributing to the improvement of financial reporting on a worldwide basis during a her tenure at the SEC. I will miss her wise and excellent counsel."

Ms. Tokar joined the SEC in 1994 as a Professional Accounting Fellow. In 1996 she was appointed an Associate Chief Accountant; she was promoted to Senior Associate Chief Accountant in September 1997. Since 1999 she has served as the chair of the International Organization of Securities Commission's (IOSCO) Working Party No. 1 on Multinational Disclosures and Accounting. Ms. Tokar also has been an observer member of the Board of the International Accounting Standards Committee and of several of its steering committees.

As chair of the IOSCO Working Party Ms. Tokar oversaw IOSCO's assessment and report on the IASC core standards project, which was approved by IOSCO's membership at its annual conference in May 2000. She was active in a number of international initiatives both within the Commission and with other U.S. government

agencies, including the Trans Atlantic Business Dialogue. She also assisted Chairman Arthur Levitt in his role as chair of the IASC Nominating Committee.

Ms. Tokar said, "Working at the SEC offered me unparalleled opportunities to address important issues while drawing on the resources of the incredibly talented and committed group of people who make up the Commission and its staff. For most of my career I've worked with cross-border issuers coming to U.S. capital markets and the last four years have been a unique opportunity to help shape the future of international accounting and reporting in that environment. It's been a particular honor to have a leadership role within IOSCO at a critical time and very satisfying to have been part of IOSCO's significant accomplishments in this area."

Ms. Tokar, 41, graduated from Williams College and earned an MBA from NYU's Stern School of Business. (Press Rel. 2000-104)

RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

DESIGNATION OF NASD REGULATION, INC. TO ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN THE INVESTMENT ADVISER REGISTRATION DEPOSITORY; APPROVAL OF IARD FEES

A notice and order has been issued designating NASD Regulation, Inc. to establish and maintain a new electronic filing and disclosure system for investment advisers called the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and approving IARD filing fees. (Rel. IA-1888)

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

IN THE MATTER OF DAVID BARR

An administrative law judge has censured and imposed a \$50,000 civil penalty on David T. Barr for violations of Sections 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act of 1933 in connection with the sale of unregistered shares of International Trade & Commerce Corp. Administrative Law Judge Brenda P. Murray rejected allegations by the Division of Enforcement that Mr. Barr violated Section 17(a)(1), an antifraud provision of the Securities Act, by sending press releases that contained false information about ITC to two individuals who called and asked Mr. Barr for information. Judge Murray found that Mr. Barr did not intend to deceive, manipulate or defraud and that he acted based on false information given to him by Phebe Erdman. Mr. Barr had known Mrs. Erdman and the three Erdman children for many years. Mr. Barr was unaware that Mrs. Erdman and her husband, the late Ellis Erdman, were engaged in a scheme to "pump and dump" ITC shares. Judge Murray found that Mr. Barr mistakenly thought he could assist Mrs.

Erdman by doing the paper work on a negotiated sale and having buyers sign a letter acknowledging that he did not solicit their stock purchases.

In related action, in 1999 a United States District Court in Florida in an action brought by the Securities and Exchange Commission on the same facts, enjoined Mrs. Erdman and Hans Erdman from violating the provisions of the security statutes and ordered them to disgorge \$139,010 and \$55,240, respectively. The same court ordered Rebecca Erdman to disgorge \$20,211 and Leslie Erdman Cherkin to disgorge \$27,110. (Initial Decision No. 170; File No. 3-9585)

COMMISSION BARS THIRD BROKERAGE EMPLOYEE IN IBM/LOTUS INSIDER TRADING CASE

On July 27, the Commission issued an order by consent barring Jonah Rosenblatt of Far Rockaway, New York from associating with any broker or dealer for three years based on a permanent injunction entered against him for committing insider trading on June 2, 1995, in advance of International Business Machines Corporation's takeover of Lotus Development Corporation. Rosenblatt previously had agreed to the entry of the injunction as well as disgorgement and pre-judgment interest of \$692,401, which the Commission waived based on his financial inability to pay. SEC FILES AND SETTLES INSIDER TRADING CASE

The Commission announced that on July 10 it filed a civil injunctive action alleging illegal insider trading before a November 10, 1998 announcement that Roanoke Electric Steel Corp. would make a tender offer for the outstanding shares of Steel of West Virginia, Inc. at a price of \$10.75 per share. The complaint alleges that on November 4, 1998, defendant Roger Bernhammer, of Hasbrouck Heights, New Jersey, learned of the then proposed tender offer in the course of his employment at SWVA's transfer agent and that in breach of a duty of trust and confidence owed to his employer, he purchased 500 shares of SWVA common stock, thereby obtaining illegal profits of \$2,220. Bernhammer admitted the allegations of the complaint and consented to the entry of a final judgment which permanently enjoins him from future violations of antifraud provision of the federal securities laws, orders him to disgorge \$2,220 plus prejudgment interest and orders him to pay a civil penalty of \$2,220.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT

BILL GROSS' IDEALAB!

An order has been issued under Section 3(b)(2) of the Investment Company Act granting Bill Gross' idealab! (idealab!) a temporary exemption from all provisions of the Act. Idealab! filed an application on January 28, 2000 for an order under Section 3(b)(2) declaring that it is not an investment company. The temporary order further extends the sixty day automatic exemption provided by Section 3(b)(2) upon the filing of an application in good faith until September 25, 2000. Prior to the issuance of a permanent order to idealab!, if any, the Commission will issue a notice giving interested persons an opportunity to request a hearing. (Rel. IC-24567 – July 26)

PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

A proposed rule change (SR-Amex-00-22) was filed by the American Stock Exchange pursuant to Section 19(b)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The rule change: (1) gives the Exchange's Enforcement Department the right to appeal a decision of a Disciplinary Panel; and (2) gives the Amex Adjudicatory Counsel and Amex Board of Governors authority to increase penalties imposed by a Disciplinary Panel. The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by the Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-PHLX-00-69) to modify the concentration requirements for the Gold/Silver Index. IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the Chicago Stock Exchange creating a new registration fee and annual fee for off-floor proprietary securities traders for CHX member firms for which the CHX acts as designated examining authority (SR-CHX-00-23) has become effective under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.
