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## RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

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### PREVIOUSLY PROPOSED AMENDMENTS ADOPTED

The Commission adopted previously proposed amendments to the forms and rules for the registration and monitoring of transfer agents. Revised Form TA-1 will remain essentially the same as the present Form TA-1, except several questions that are viewed as no longer necessary have been deleted, and others have been shifted to Form TA-2. The SEC Supplement to Form TA-1, which is to be completed only by independent, non-issuer transfer agents who register with the Commission, will provide information about persons associated with transfer agents. Rule 17Ac2-2 will require transfer agents, regardless of their appropriate regulatory agency, to file with the Commission an annual report of their business activities on Form TA-2. Finally, the modification to Rule 17Ac2-1(c) extends the time period for a registrant to file corrections to Form TA-1 or to the SEC Supplement. (Rel. 34-23084)

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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### COMMISSION ANNOUNCES STAFF CHANGES

Chairman John Shad today announced John J. Huber has resigned from the Commission to enter the private practice of law, that Linda C. Quinn will replace Mr. Huber as Director of the Division of Corporation Finance and that Joseph Goldstein has been named Executive Assistant to the Chairman, replacing Ms. Quinn. All appointments are effective in late April. (Press Releases 86-18 through 21)

### BEVERLY HILLS BANCORP.

The Commission, in the reorganization case of Beverly Hills Bancorp. under Chapter X of the Bankruptcy Act, announced that the district court sustained its objection to an application seeking to modify a material provision of the previously confirmed plan of reorganization. The application sought to eliminate or reduce a line of credit established to secure a provision of the plan providing for a limited tender offer to all shareholders who held less than 500 shares as of a certain date. In denying the application, the court agreed with the Commission that a reduction in the amount of the letter of credit would amount to a material modification of the plan, requiring notice to and approval by the affected class of shareholders. (In re Beverly Hills Bancorp., No. 74-4409 JWC, RBS, CDCA). (CR-355)

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST ROBERT MITCHELL

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on March 27 Judge Charles Norgle of the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division, entered an Order of Permanent Injunction against Robert Mitchell from future violations of the securities, broker-dealer registration provisions and antifraud provisions of the securities laws.

The July 1, 1985 complaint alleges that from about February 1984 to about July 1984, Mitchell and others offered and sold unregistered securities in the form of partnership interests in oil and gas wells to hundreds of investors nationwide and raised several million dollars. The complaint further alleges that the defendants made misrepresentations and omissions concerning, among other things, the history of sanctions

entered against them by various state agencies and state and federal courts, the cost of the wells, the investment risks, the identity of the drilling company, the sales commissions and the misuse of investor proceeds. Additionally, the complaint alleges that Mitchell and others acted as unregistered securities brokers. (SEC v. Alvin Petroleum, Inc., et al., Civil Action No. 85C 06032, filed July 1, 1985). #### CIVIL CONTEMPT PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST CHAROLETTE AND EDWARD GARRITY

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on March 14 a Notice and Motion For an Order to Show Cause and For an Order Adjudging Charolette and Edward Garrity in Civil Contempt was filed in the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Indiana.

An August 9, 1984 Temporary Restraining Order and an October 5, 1984 Preliminary Injunction previously had enjoined the Garritys from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws and had placed a freeze on their assets. In April 1985, C. Garrity had been held in civil contempt of the 1984 Orders as a result of her activities in a company she operated known as Collectables. A warrant for her arrest was issued after she failed to comply with the Civil Contempt Order.

The March 14 Notice alleged that the Garritys have again violated the 1984 Orders by fraudulently selling, since January 1986, \$100,000 in unregistered securities in an investment program they operated known as International Diversified Corporation (IDC). The Garritys were arrested in Wyoming on March 7, 1986. Each is being held by Wyoming authorities on \$250,000 bond while awaiting a hearing on state criminal charges in connection with their IDC activities. (SEC v. Charolette Garrity, et al., Civil Action No. S84-0484, filed August 9, 1984). (LR-11049)

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### FIDELITY CALIFORNIA TAX-FREE FUND

An order has been issued exempting Fidelity California Tax-Free Fund and other registered investment companies advised by Fidelity Management & Research Company from the provisions of Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act. The exemption permits Applicants to pay a portion of the premium of a mutual fund errors and omissions and trustee liability insurance policy. (Rel. IC-15031 - April 2)

### HERITAGE CAPITAL APPRECIATION TRUST

An order has been issued on an application of Heritage Capital Appreciation Trust and Heritage Cash Trust, registered open-end, diversified, management companies, and their principal underwriter, Raymond, James & Associates, Inc., approving certain exchange offers. (Rel. IC-15032 - April 2)

### STRATEGIC ISRAELI FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 28 to request a hearing on an application by Strategic Israeli Fund Inc. for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-15034 - April 2)

### MUNICIPAL INVESTMENT TRUST FUND

An order has been issued exempting Municipal Investment Trust Fund, a series of unit investment trusts, their sponsors, and Financial Guaranty Insurance Company from the provisions of Sections 17(a), 17(d) and 26(a)(2)(c) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 to permit any series of the Trusts to purchase certain insurance from an affiliate of the Sponsors. 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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change of Depository Trust Company (SR-DTC-85-6) that revises its fee schedule for major DTC services. (Rel. 34-23080)

ORDER PARTIALLY APPROVING PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved partially a proposed rule change of Depository Trust Company (SR-DTC-77-10) which allows it to charge a fee to National Securities Clearing Corporation for certain services. (Rel. 34-23082)

DETERMINATION OF WHETHER TO APPROVE/DISAPPROVE RULE CHANGE;  
TIME FOR ACTION ON PROPOSED RULE CHANGES EXTENDED

The Commission instituted proceedings to determine whether to partially disapprove a proposed rule change of Depository Trust Company (SR-DTC-77-10) and extended the time for action on proposed rule changes of DTC (SR-DTC-77-3), Midwest Securities Trust Company (SR-MSTC-77-1), and Pacific Securities Depository Trust Company (SR-PSDTC-77-2). The proposals relate to fees for depository interface activity. (Rel. 34-23083)

Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
