CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

TOLEDO TECHNOLOGY, INC. NAMED IN COMPLAINT

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on April 24 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Toledo Technology, Inc. of Irving, Texas. The complaint alleges violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws and seeks a Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Equitable Relief.

The Commission alleges that Toledo, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended September 30, 1985, its Quarterly Report on Form 10-Q for its fiscal quarter ended December 31, 1985, and Notifications of Late Filing. The Commission requests that the Court order Toledo to file its delinquent Annual and Quarterly Reports and enjoin it from further violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws. CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

CORPORATE OFFICERS INDICTED ON FALSE FILING AND CONSPIRACY CHARGES

The Seattle Regional Office and Charles Turner, U.S. Attorney for the District of Oregon, announced that on March 27 a federal grand jury sitting in Portland, Oregon, with Judge William Dale presiding, returned an 11-count indictment against James R. Anderson, former president and director of American Guaranty Financial Corp. of Portland, Oregon, and Frank R. Cooper, a former director. Anderson was charged with one count of conspiracy and eight counts of filing false 10-Ks and using false proxy materials. Cooper was charged with one count of conspiracy and two counts of filing false 10-Ks and using false proxy materials. The conspiracy charge, one filing count and one proxy count arose out of Cooper and Anderson failing to disclose a kick-back arrangement on a loan transaction by AG Financial. Anderson was also charged on these and other counts for failing to disclose his son had a material interest in a company with transactions with AG Financial and for failing to disclose he owned an 8% interest in an AG Financial subsidiary. Arraignment for Anderson and Cooper was held April 7 in the U.S. District Court in Portland. Both defendants pleaded not guilty to all charges. Trial issued for August 6. (U.S. v. James R. Anderson and Frank R. Cooper, File No. CR-86-63 USDC DOR). (LR-11075)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

LIQUIDITY MANAGEMENT GROUP -- SHORT TERM TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 16 to request a hearing on an application by Liquidity Management Group -- Short Term Trust for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-15069 - April 24)

NUVEEN CALIFORNIA TAX-FREE FUND, INC.

An order has been issued granting Nuveen California Tax-Free Fund, Inc., John Nuveen & Co. Incorporated, Nuveen Advisory Corp. and all future investment companies similar to the California Fund sponsored or advised by Nuveen or Nuveen Advisory exemptions from Section 18(f)(1), 18(g) and 18(i) of the Investment Company Act. The exemptions will permit the issuance and sale of separate classes of securities representing interests in existing and future portfolios and to allocate voting rights thereto and pay dividends thereon. An order has been issued permitting certain offers of exchange by Principal World Fund Inc., Principal Equity Fund, Inc., Principal Arizona Tax-Free Fund, Inc. and Principal Investors Corporation. (Rel. IC-15071 - April 24)

METLIFE - STATE STREET EQUITY TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 16 to request a hearing on an application by MetLife - State Street Equity Trust for an order permitting the assessment and waiver of a contingent deferred sales charge on certain redemptions of its shares. (Rel. IC-15072 - April 24)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

A Notice of and Order for Hearing has been issued on a proposal by The Columbia Gas System, Inc., a registered holding company, and its newly organized subsidiary, Tri-Star Gas Marketing, Inc., regarding the organization of and the initial financing of TriStar, consisting of the issuance and sale of up to \$5 million of common stock to Columbia, the issuance and sale of up to \$15 million of short-term notes commercial lenders (and, if required, the guarantee by Columbia of such notes) and, as an alternative to such notes, open account advances of up to \$15 million from Columbia. Tri-Star is being established to buy spot-market gas for resale to Columbia's distribution companies and nonassociates.

The time and place of the hearing will be fixed by further order. Any person, other than Columbia and TriStar, desiring to be heard or otherwise wishing to participate in this proceeding should file with the Secretary of the Commission by May 21, in the manner prescribed in the order, an application under Rule 9 of the Commission's Rules of Practice. SOUTHWESTERN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY;
PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF OKLAHOMA

Orders have been issued authorizing Southwestern Electric Power Company and Public Service Company of Oklahoma, subsidiaries of Central and South West Corporation, to issue and sell up to \$65 million and \$100 million, respectively, of their first mortgage bonds. (Rel. 35-24066; 35-24068 - April 23)

AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Incorporated filed Amendment No. 2 to a proposed rule change (SR-CBOE-85-40) to amend its proposal to increase position limits for options on Treasury Bonds and Notes to establish a \$1.2 billion cap on positions in such options. (Rel. 34-23164)

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
