OPEN MEETING - TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 27, 1994 - 2:30 P.M.

The subject matter of the open meeting scheduled for Tuesday, September, 27, 1994, at 2:30 p.m., will be:

1. The Commission will consider whether to amend Rule 10b-10 and adopt Rule 11Ac1-3 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 generally requiring disclosure by broker-dealers of the practice of payment for order flow. In addition, the Commission will consider whether to delegate the authority to grant exemptions from Rule 11Ac1-3 to the Director of the Division of Market Regulation. 2. The Commission will consider whether to issue a release proposing and soliciting comment on Rule 15c5-1. The rule would prohibit a market maker in a NASDAQ/NMS security from trading for its own account, directly or indirectly, at a price at which the market maker could execute a customer limit order that it is holding, without executing the customer limit order at such price or a price more favorable to the customer, under the specific terms and conditions by which the order is accepted by the market maker. There are certain itemized exceptions to the rule as well as specific provisions governing the type of orders and the class of persons eligible for protection under the rule. 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## **ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS**

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### **FORMER PRUDENTIAL BROKER CHARGED WITH MISAPPROPRIATING OVER \$3.2 MILLION FROM CLIENTS**

The Commission announced that on September 21 it filed a complaint in the United States District Court for the Western District of New York charging Peggy Jean Homuth (Homuth), formerly a registered representative at Prudential Securities Inc. in its Rochester, New York branch, with violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder in connection with her misappropriation of over \$3.2 million from her Prudential clients. The Commission's complaint alleges that between October 1989 and April 1993 Homuth engaged in an elaborate scheme whereby she took money from at least thirty-five of her clients' accounts by forging their signatures, diverting their monthly account statements and misrepresenting the value of their investments. The complaint further alleges that Homuth used the money for her personal use.

Simultaneously with the filing of the complaint, Homuth consented to the entry of a final judgment permanently enjoining her from future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, as well as ordering her to disgorge the \$3,217,644 she took from her customers plus prejudgment interest. Disgorgement and the imposition of a civil penalty pursuant to the Securities Enforcement Remedies and Penny Stock Reform Act of 1990 will be waived based on Homuth's demonstrated inability to pay.

Homuth, who pled guilty on September 20, 1994 to charges of mail fraud brought by the United States Attorney's Office for the Western District of New York in connection with her theft of client funds, also faces a prison term of 33 to 41 months and a fine of \$7,500 to \$75,000 for her fraudulent conduct. Homuth, who currently resides in Mt. Prospect, Illinois, is scheduled to be sentenced on November 29, 1994. [SEC v. Peggy Jean Homuth, 94 Civ. 6458-T, WDNY] (LR-14245)

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## **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

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### **JEFFERSON-PILOT LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.**

#### THE EQUITABLE LIFE ASSURANCE SOCIETY OF THE UNITED STATES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 17 to request a hearing on an application for an order pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting The Equitable Life Assurance Society of the United States (Equitable) and its affiliates, in their capacities as investment advisers, principal underwriters and depositors, from the provisions of Section 9(a) of the Act with respect to Equitable's separate accounts organized as unit investment trusts that derive assets from the sale of variable annuity contracts. The exemptions do not apply to Equitable's (and its affiliates') officers, directors and employees who participate directly in the management or administration of the separate accounts or their underlying investment companies, or in the sale of their variable annuity contracts.
