

**Application for Woodcutting Special Use Permit
Warm Springs Juniper Cut Unit
Malheur National Wildlife Refuge**

A Special Use Permit is required for all woodcutting activities on the Refuge.

Permits will only be issued Monday through Thursday from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at Refuge Headquarters, 36391 Sodhouse Lane, Princeton, Oregon 97721. For more information call 541-493-2612.

The Warm Springs Juniper Cut Unit is located south of the community of Frenchglen. Access to the cut area is from P Lane via a two-track refuge road. Juniper available for woodcutting is located on the west side of this two-track road. The unit contains steep, rocky slopes and caution is advised.

Special Conditions:

- Period of permit: March 23 – August 1, 2009
- Cutting permitted only when access gate is open*
- Woodcutting is restricted to the Warm Springs Juniper Cut Unit and is identified on the attached map
- Burns Interagency Fire Restrictions apply and may result in early closure of woodcutting activities
- Permit may not be used for economic gain
- Woodcutting is limited to daylight hours
- No ATV use is allowed
- Permit must be placed on dash of vehicle while on the refuge
- No mechanized equipment (skidder, loaders, winches, etc.) allowed
- No camping or campfires
- Permit holder should make every effort to minimize the spread of noxious weeds
- Permit holder will pile limbs on remaining tree top after removing wood
- Off road access is limited to specific areas and only when soils are dry or frozen
- Limited turn around areas may preclude use of trailers
- Do not block road

* The **Access Gate** may be closed periodically to minimize damage to the road during wet conditions. Permit holders should call 541-493-2612 to learn about access and road conditions before travelling to the Refuge.
