Atlantic Shark Commercial Fishery Update

Below are preliminary landings estimates in metric tons (mt) and pounds (lbs) dressed weight (dw) for the Atlantic shark commercial fisheries for the 2nd and 3rd trimester seasons of 2006. The landings estimates include landing reports received as of January 16, 2007; however, these reports represent preliminary landings, as some dealers have not yet reported. The landings presented below are total landings reported through the Pelagic Dealer Compliance (PDC) and the Automated Landings Reporting System (ALS), often referred to as the Quota Monitoring System and General Canvass, respectively. Quotas, season lengths, and opening dates for the second and third trimester season will be announced in an upcoming proposed rule.
