Atlantic Shark Commercial Fishery Update

Below are **preliminary** landings estimates in metric tons (mt) and pounds (lb) dressed weight (dw) for the Atlantic shark commercial fisheries for the 1st, and 2nd trimester seasons of 2006, and the season dates and quotas for the 3rd trimester. The landings estimates include landing reports received as of August 24, 2006. Unusually high landings of large coastal sharks (LCS) were reported for the South Atlantic during the first trimester season of 2006. NMFS has examined all available data sources to ensure that the landings reported below are correct. A proposed rule will likely be published in September/October 2006 announcing the season dates and quotas for the first trimester of 2007.
