Atlantic Shark Commercial Fishery Update

Below are **preliminary** landings estimates in metric tons (mt) and pounds (lb) dressed weight (dw) for the Atlantic shark commercial fisheries for the 1st trimester season of 2006 and the season dates and quotas for the 2nd trimester season of 2006. The landings estimates include landing reports received as of May 16, 2006.

Unusually high landings of large coastal sharks were reported for the South Atlantic during the first trimester season of 2006. NMFS has been working during the past month to verify these numbers and will continue to examine all available data sources to ensure that the landings reported below are correct. Although landings in the South Atlantic region during 2006 were significantly greater than shark landings during the same season in 2004 and 2005, examination of historical landings indicate that individual dealer activity was not abnormally high, with increased landings evenly distributed among all dealers. To date, all dealer reporting forms have been double checked for entry errors including counting Gulf of Mexico catch towards the South Atlantic quota, duplicate entries, and inclusion of catch from other seasons. Upon examining the dealer report forms, it became evident that seven of the reports included landings from both the Gulf of Mexico and the South Atlantic. State trip tickets are currently being examined to attempt to determine the ratio of the purchases that originated in each region. Additional shark fishery updates will be released as further work is completed to eliminate the possibility of errors in landing estimates. No determinations have been made regarding the effect of this overharvest on the 2007 1st trimester fishing season.
