#### **BED BUG SPECIMEN EVALUATION**

Homeowners, tenants and property managers may occasionally discover bed bugs in their homes and apartments. We suggest you have the specimens examined to confirm their identity **before** you consider treating the residence. This is important because many other kinds of insects are easily confused with bed bugs, and because treating a home or apartment can be costly, difficult, and hazardous if not done correctly.

We provide an opportunity for you to confirm the identity of the bugs you discovered. We will examine the samples you find, and reply with our observations. Specifically, we will tell you the kind of insect you found, whether these are of concern, and what you may do to manage these pests. The samples you submit are considered for entomological identification; they are not to be regarded as clinical laboratory specimens. Consult with your physician for medical advice and diagnosis.

The information you provide on this form will help us evaluate the sample and respond to you. By completing and submitting the attached form, you consent for us to examine the sample and to contact you later. Although your only foreseeable risk would be a loss of confidentiality, please be aware that we shall not share your name or identifying information with anyone outside of our laboratory. All records will be securely maintained until they are destroyed. Please do not include information beyond that requested on the form.

Send us the evaluation form (with samples attached), payment and a self-addressed envelope. Include a check or money order to defray handling costs and to assist with our research and teaching activities. Once we receive your specimen, it may us take one or more days to process it and send you a reply.
