ARINC Incorporated ("ARINC"), headquartered at 2551 Riva Road, Annapolis Maryland, is an aeronautical engineering company providing worldwide communications and air traffic control services to, among others, airlines and civil aviation authorities. In that endeavor, ARINC purchases and resells aeronautical Immarast mobile satellits services (MSS) that rely on ground earth station (QES) processing and distribution facilities owned and operated by several international telecommunications companies.

Currently, ARINC enjoys relationships with several Imperest GES providers, including Comeat Mobile Communications ("CMC") and Telenor Satellite Services, AS. As part of its service offerings, ARINC resells Immerest Aero-H, Aero-L, and Aero-H+ services from both CMC and Telenor. ARINC believes that the merger of CMC and Telenor will harm neither ARINC's interests or the interests of those whom it serves. Accordingly, ARINC generally supports the sale of CMC to Telenor.
