It is with great pleasure that we announce that we are discontinuing the hard copy distribution of the "List of Parties Excluded From Federal Procurement and Nonprocurement Programs" published monthly by the General Services Administration. However, it will probably take a couple of months until USAID is actually taken off GSA's system.

Now that all USAID posts except those listed below have access to the internet, it enables the Agency to use the more current internet version of the list, rather than the hard copy.
