

Notes on version, and installation of QL-PAY, March 13, 2009

VERSION, BUILD, REVISION

QL-PAY version: 5.20.

QL-PAY.EXE:

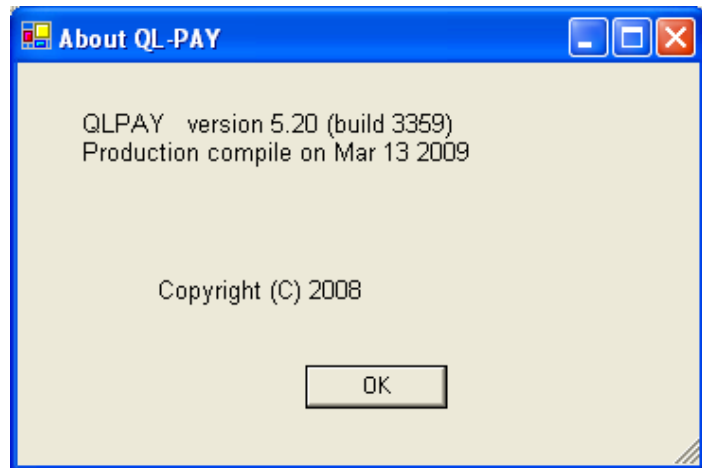
Current build: 3359

The date of this Build is March 13, 2009

PROPDEFS.EXE:

Current build revision: 75

The date of this Build is December 19, 2007.



Major, minor versions:

Versions 3.* were 16 bit DOS versions.

Versions 4.* were 16-bit Windows versions.

Version 5.0 was the first 32-bit version but was never released. Several versions from 5.01 through 5.06 were also never released; these represent different configurations the program evolved through on its way to a releasable version.

Version 5.10 is the first 32-bit version set to be released.

Version 5.20 reflects changes in asphalt binder pay factors and streamlines data output.

QLPAY.EXE build.

Following Microsoft's current default dotNet implementations, the build number is based on the day the program was compiled (specifically the number of days since Jan 1, 2000).

PROPDEFS.EXE build, revision.

The build and revision follow an older system where the build number is incremented by a compiler run macro and the revision number is left at 0.

INSTALLATION

DO NOT UNINSTALL the current version 4 program.

The user will need to run version 4 and export all of the current data sets to text (.dat) files. After exporting (be sure to note the export directory location) the user will need to run version 5 and import the files. All of the files (*.dat) can be imported into version 5 at one time and a conversion in data formats will occur automatically as the files are imported. Depending on the size and number of files being imported this can take a few minutes for 3 to 5 files, to several hours for 1,000 files. Most project personnel will have fewer than 20 files requiring import.

NOTE: When importing the files the computer may appear to be locked up during the conversion process. This is normal, just be patient and normal operation will eventually resume. When converting several hundred files at once — go have lunch! The time required to import the data files depends on the number and size of the files being converted, the processor speed and the amount of RAM available.

DO NOT INSTALL version 5 in the same directory as version 4.

Version 5.20 revised the data base and will read older files and automatically convert them to the new format. However, once the files are converted there is no going back to a previous version of

the program. It is therefore recommended that you backup all of the files before deleting the previous installation and beginning the installation of version 5.20.

INSTALLATION: You will need Administrative Rights to perform the install. Double click: qlpay.msi
