DOCUMENT DESIGNATION	DATE	NATURE AND EFFECT OF ACTION AND AMENDMENTS
EO PW Res 107	4/17/1926	Every smallest legal subdivision of the Public Land surveys which is vacant, unappropriated, unreserved, Public Land and contains a spring or water hole, and all lands within ¼ mile of every spring or water hole located on unsurveyed Public Land are withdrawn, from settlement, location, sale, or entry and reserved for public use and in aid of legislation. Lands may be rejected from application or offers if classification procedures determine that a spring or water hole is contained on such land.
EO Wdl 5327	4/15/1930	The deposits of oil shale and lands containing such deposits owned by the U.S. are temporarily withdrawn from lease or other disposal and reserved for purposes of investigation, examination and classification. Land may be rejected from offers or applications if classification procedures determine such land contains oil shale deposits. Amended EO 6016 2/6/1933; EO 7036 5/13/1935.
EO Wdl 5389	7/7/1930	Every smallest legal subdivision of the Public Land surveys which is vacant, unappropriated, unreserved, Public Land and contains a hot spring or a spring that waters of which contain curative properties, and all lands within ¼ mile of such spring located on unsurveyed Public Land are withdrawn from settlement, location, sale or entry and reserved for lease Lands may be rejected from applications or offers if classification procedures determine that such a spring is contained on such land. Amended PLO 399 8/20/1947; PLO 614 10/19/1949.
EO 6016 Amends EO 5327 4/15/1930	2/6/1933	Secretary of the Interior is authorized to issue oil and gas permits and leases on lands containing oil shale deposits.
O	7/19/1934	Temporary withdrawal of all unentered, unreserved, unappropriated and undisposed of Public Land within Apache, Navajo, and Coconino counties. Revoked SO 1/29/1942.
EO Temp Wdl 6910	11/26/1934	Temporarily withdraws all vacant, unreserved and unappropriated Public Land from settlement, location, sale or entry and reserves such land for classification pending determination of the most useful purpose to which such land may be put and for conservation and development if natural resources. Amended EO 7048 5/20/1935; EO 7235 11/26/1935; EO 7274 1/14/1936; EO 7599 4/1/1937.
EO 7038 Amends EO 5327 4/15/1930	5/13/1935	Secretary of the Interior is authorized to issue sodium permits and leases on lands containing oil shale deposits.
EO 7048 Amends EO 6910 11/26/1934	5/20/1935	Included lands subject to withdrawal or other appropriation at the time EO 6910 issued and subsequently released. Secretary of the Interior is authorized to effect exchanges affected by EO 6910 in his discretion.
EO 7235 Amends EO 6910 11/26/1934	11/26/1935	Authorizes sale or leasing of land under Act of June 28, 1934 and provides that the withdrawal shall not debar the recognition of non-metalliferous mining claims.
EO 7274 Amends EO 6910 11/26/1934	1/14/1936	Excludes all land within grazing districts from classification while such lands remain a part of a grazing district.
EO 7599 Amends EO 6910 11/26/1934	4/1/1937	Excludes lands which upon acceptance of survey would otherwise become a part of a school land grant of designated sections.

EO Wdl 9613	9/13/1945	All lands which contain deposits of radioactive mineral substances and all deposits of such substances, are withdrawn from sale and other forms of disposal under Public Land laws including the mining laws, and reserved for use of the U. S. also, land acquired by and in process of acquisition by U.S. Revoked PLO 585 8/13/1954.
EO 9701	3/8/1946	Provides for the reservation of rights to fissionable materials in lands owned by the U. S.
PLO 399 Amends EO 5389 7/7/1930	8/20/1947	Not applicable to lands within the National Forest since such lands are now under jurisdiction of the Secretary of Agriculture.
PLO 614 Amends EO 5389 7/7/1930	10/19/1949	Does not affect lands now outside of National Forest or hereafter eliminated from National Forest by reason of the proximity of such lands to any such springs in a National Forest.
Asst SO	10/27/1952	Extends certain military withdrawals indefinitely.
PLO. 585 Revokes EO 9613 9/13/1945		
PL 585	8/19/1958	Quitclaimed, remised, and released all reservations of fissionable source materials that were reserved under the authority of the Atomic Energy Act of 1946.
PLO 5444 Revocation	11/4/1974	Revokes all withdrawals affecting Patented or Privately owned lands in which all right, title, or interest have been conveyed, except withdrawals for powersite reserves and powersite classifications.
