Dear Comrade -

O. F. Mr. H. H. Lane has sent me
a clipping from T. U. as to
the flag of 1st 14th at Columbus
Ohio. You remember that on
3rd of Dec 1863 - the two regiments
of regts were consolidated at
Dalton Ga. The old flags were
sent to Tallahassee, and the flag
was issued to 1st 14th

Green Bryant of Co. I, 4th was
bearer - & carried it until
Dec. 7. 1864, when it was taken
from him - on the Milledgeville
pike north of Milledgeville.
You served under the flag under
Col Maxwell was a prisoner
Col Ed Hopkins of Ia
1st Col of Ia - I think
Lee captured as much
to it - as our Miles

Caught at Madison
Major J. A. Lark was
the day it was captured

The Madison Co. was "C" of the
4th the Color Co. of original - capt
