aged 63 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical George Nickel

who was ENROLLED on the 7th day of August, 1862, in Company 6 of the 106th regiment of Ohio Inf Vols

commanded by Captain Kaufmann and was honorably DISCHARGED at Nashville Tenn on the 12th day of July, 1865. That his

personal description is as follows: Age 63 years; height 5 feet 11 inches; complexion fair hair dark; eyes blue

That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of duty at Hartsville in the State of Tennessee

on or about the 7th day of December, 1862, he was taken prisoner

by the Rebels and taken to Harpersburg Tenn Here state the name or nature of disease, or the location of wound or injury. If disabled by disease, state fully its cause; if by wound or injury, the precise manner in which received.

where after an exposure of about seven days without food or shelter, in consequence of which exposure he contracted Cycloplegia in face and upon different parts of body. The disease settling more in face than any other part of body and affecting him to such an extent as to render him unable to work more than half his time up to the present date from the time of his discharge from service.

That he was treated in hospitals as follows: in "Cumberland Hospital" Here state the names or numbers, and the localities of all hospitals in which treated, and the dates of treatment.

That he has never been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above. Here state what the service

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the County of Scioto & Jackson Co in the state of Ohio, and that his occupation has been that of a Laborer For a short time

That prior to his entry into the service above named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when enrolled a Laborer

That he is now fully one half disabled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States. He hereby appoints with full power of substitution and revocation.
